# **ACC Foundation Plans** 21st Annual Scramble for **Scholarships**

Plans are currently underway for the Alpena Community College Foundation's 21st annual Robert M. Granum Memorial Scramble for Scholarships. The event will be held on Saturday, August 19, with a 9 a.m. shot-gun start at the River's Edge Golf Club.



The tournament is a four-person best ball scramble where golfers of all skill levels can enjoy themselves. Golfers will have the opportunity to win great prizes that have been donated by area businesses as well as wonderful golf packages to premier courses.

The entry fee is \$90 per person and includes 18 holes of golf with a cart, beverages, lunch and snacks following the tournament. Prizes will be awarded to the first, second, and third place teams in addition to best score for a mixed team and additional golf packages for several random place teams.

Since 1996, this tournament has been the ACC Foundation's signature fundraising event and approximately \$350,000 has been raised. The 2016 event netted a total of \$17,327 and provided a total of 55 scholarships to students during the 2016-2017 academic year.

# **ACC Debuts New Website and Logo**



As part of their endeavors to maintain a modern image, Alpena Community College is proud to have both a new logo and a new website. The new logo (left) is reminiscent of the previous logo, but with a modern twist. ACC has had a number of logos throughout history, with the most recent logo being introduced in 1990. By eliminating the graphic portion and focusing solely on the text portion, the new logo is simple, bold, and modern.

The logo, debuted at Staff Start Up Day in January 2017, is being introduced across both campuses via a slow roll out. Publications, campus documents, items in the bookstore, advertisements, and more will replace the logo as new items are needed, with the ultimate goal of having the logo fully implemented by January 2019.

In addition to a new logo, ACC debuted a new website in July 2017. The new website is more image-based rather than text-based and provides new ways for users to interact with the website. The website follows a similar organizational set-up as the previous site, but with a modern and professional twist. "We've known that images are a better way to capture the attention of our visitors, and we wanted to make that a strong component to the new website," said ACC Communications Technician Jess Ruppert. "We

have such a beautiful campus and our students get such a hands-on experience here, now with this website we're able to really show the full ACC experience."

The website took over a year to fully implement, with brainstorming sessions that started last June between the Office of Public Information and the Director of Learning Technology. From there, they worked through various drafts, concepts, and possible features until they developed the sitemap, migrated the content over, and rebuilt the pages. # Getting Started at ACC

### **Applying**

Alpena Community College grants admission to all persons who have earned a high school diploma or GED, or who are 18 years of age or older and who demonstrate the ability to benefit from a particular program of study. Stop by or call ACC in Alpena or Oscoda to get an ACC Application for Admission (use our toll-free number: 1.888.468.6222). You can also apply online at www.alpenacc.edu. Complete and submit your application for free; there is no application fee at ACC.

### **Financial Aid**

Apply for financial aid as soon as you decide to take courses. Submit the Free

Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online as soon as possible. Apply online at www.fafsa.gov and authorize electronic release of the results (called the Student Aid Report or SAR) to ACC by including our code number, 002237.

### **Assessment**

The dates and times of placement assessment tests are listed on page 6. Attend the testing session convenient for you in Alpena or Oscoda. It's free; there is no charge for ACC placement assessment. The ACCUPLACER test can be waived if you have a sub score of 18 or higher on the ACT in the areas of Math, Reading and English.

### Orientation/Registration

All new students must attend a mandatory orientation session where they will meet with an advisor, register for classes, and get a better feel for college expectations. Your advisor will help you plan what courses you need to take to achieve your academic goals. Choose the most convenient orientation time at either the Alpena or Oscoda campus. Bring the registration form that you and your advisor filled out. Turn it in and be ready to pay the tuition and fees for your course(s).

Yes, at this step, you do have to pay whatever balance remains after any financial aid you are receiving is applied. Even so, ACC's rates are affordable ... and parking is free!

### **Books**

The ACC Bookstore has your textbooks, course supplies and ACC clothing and accessories. For your convenience, it is open additional hours during semester start up and has four book sale days in Oscoda. See the listing on page 6 for Bookstore hours.




The Alpena Campus is easy to find, located just east of the traffic light at U.S. 23 and Long Rapids Road/Johnson Street.




Huron Shores Campus in Oscoda

# **Registration Info**

Students can register at either location for classes at both campus. Most classes start August 28, 2017, though some courses have other start or end dates. Please check the class listings for start and end dates of the courses in which you intend to enroll.

### NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION AND REGISTRATION

All new students are required to attend a New Student Orientation session prior to registering for classes. During orientation students will hear about being a student at ACC, learn about financial aid, and meet with an academic advisor to schedule classes for the coming semester. ### REVISED LATE REGISTRATION POLICY — EFFECTIVE FALL 2015

Students may register for classes the first week of the semester only with the authorized signature of approval by the course instructor. Department chairs may authorize and sign first week semester course enrollments on behalf of their adjunct instructors. During the second week of the semester, no registrations of in-session courses will be allowed, only course level changes (e.g. MTH 113 to MTH 102) and lateral course changes (e.g. ENG 111 to another section of ENG 111) will be allowed with approval of the course instructor(s).

### FINANCIAL AID

Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online as soon as possible. Apply online at www.fafsa.gov and authorize electronic release of the results (called the Student Aid Report or SAR) to ACC by including our code number, 002237.

### Repetitive Course Enrollment Policy

Alpena Community College credit courses may be repeated only once where any grade (i.e., A-W) has been earned. Specifically, if a course has been taken twice and any grade was earned, written permission from the office of the Registrar and Financial Aid Office (if applicable) is required prior to a third enrollment. The highest grade in the course will be used in calculating the student's grade point average.

### Important Information for Students Receiving Financial Aid:

Courses taken for Audit and courses repeated more than once after previously passing the course do not count as part of a student's financial aid enrollment status, and can affect your financial aid award. Effective date: Spring 2012 Semester.

### A Reminder for Fall 2017 Graduates

Students completing a degree or certificate program should submit a Request for Graduation form by Friday, October 6, 2017. Forms are available in the Registrar's Office, Huron Shores Office, or may be submitted via WebAdvisor. Questions may be directed to the Registrar's Office (VLH 108) There is no graduation fee.

\* In-District rates are paid by residents of the Alpena Community College District, where a voter-approved property tax levy for the College is collected each year.

Facilities Maintenance Fee.....\$6 per contact hour (Facilities Maintenance Fee collected on all classes.)

Technology Fee .....\$4 per contact hour (Technology Fee collected on Alpena & Huron Shores classes.)

Online Course Fee .....\$30 per contact hour (Online Course Fee collected for every online course)

**Special Course Fees** — A fee of \$75 per art course is applied to cover the cost of supplies. Other courses requiring a large amount of additional supplies, non-college facilities, equipment, or services (physical education, music, etc.) may require an additional fee that will be collected by the College, the agency, or the company providing the facilities, equipment or services.

Fall Semester tuition and fees are paid on a maximum of 23 contact hours. Payment is by check, money order, Visa, MasterCard, Discover, American Express or financial aid at the time of registration. Michigan Merit/Michigan Promise Award recipients must present at the time of registration a copy of their certification showing ACC as the receiving institution.

All charges are assessed and payable in United States currency at registration or as otherwise stated. Students are urged to use checks, credit cards, or money orders payable to Alpena Community College for the payment of charges. If checks and money orders are in excess of the required payments, the excess amount will be added to the student's account and may be used at the Bookstore for purchases during the enrollment period. Refunds and amounts left on student accounts at that time will be refunded to the student. Excess credit card amounts will be refunded to the credit card(s) after 60 days from date used. Online payments are now accepted through WebAdvisor. Cash is accepted at the Alpena Campus; however, no cash payments are accepted at the Huron Shores Campus. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Tuition Refund Policy: Full refund (100%) of all tuition paid will be issued if a Drop/Add Form is processed and given to the Registrar's Office (Van Lare Hall 108) in Alpena or the Huron Shores Campus Office by 3:30 p.m. the last day of enrollment for the semester. Classes may be dropped with tuition refund through Friday, September 8, 2017, by submitting a completed Drop/ Add Form.

**Please Note:** The enrollment and refund period varies for courses shorter than the regular 15-week semester. Notations appear with such courses in the listing of classes. Please contact the Alpena Registrar's Office (Van Lare Hall 108) or the Huron Shores Campus office in Oscoda for refund deadlines on these courses.

# **Placement Assessment**

Beginning Fall 2016, the ACCUPLACER placement replaced the COMPASS placement assessment.

The ACCUPLACER placement assessment is required for:

- All new Alpena Community College students who do not have A.C.T. Reading, English and Mathematics subscores of 18 or higher and wish to register for more than one course. Students who accumulate 6 credit hours by taking one course per semester will be required to take the ACCUPLACER placement test battery. (Note: placement tests will only be given in the subject areas where subscore minimums were not met.) OR
- Have not earned a minimum of 12 college credits including at least one college level course in either English or Mathematics AND
- All students who enroll for the first time in an English or mathematics course.

The ACCUPLACER Test can be waived if the student has a sub score of 18 or higher on the ACT in the areas of Math, Reading and English. Students only need to test in the area they are below an 18. The ACCUPLACER placement test is strongly recommended for all students, regardless of course load or field of study. New students must submit an Application for Admission to the Admissions Office before attending assessment. Please bring a valid photo ID. Pencils, pens, calculators and paper are provided if needed.

The Alpena Campus Testing Center is located in Van Lare Hall Room 122. The Testing Center has convenient hours to fit your busy schedule, with other testing times available by appointment. During Central Registration week, the Alpena Testing Center will have extended hours to assist students with placement testing. Please call the Testing **Center for more information.** To schedule an appointment please call the Testing Center at 989.358.7209. The Huron Shores Campus has testing located in Room 307. Call 989.358.7445 to make an appointment.

# **School Closing Policy**

Alpena Community College draws students from a large area and has two campuses located 50 miles apart. The weather can vary dramatically over this large area. Students are responsible for determining the advisability of travel during severe conditions.

In extreme situations, the College may alter its schedule of operation at the Alpena Campus and/or at the Huron Shores Campus in one of the following ways: delay morning opening; cancel classes only; or close (cancel classes and close all offices/ services). At these times, students have several ways to determine the College's status. Area radio stations and some TV stations carry delay/closure info; the College telephone greeting also informs callers of weather-related closing, cancellation of classes, or delay in opening. Call 989.356.9021 for the Alpena Campus, 989.739.1445 for the Huron Shores Campus. ACC also features SchoolMessenger, a text messaging and e-mail service that provides alert notification services for emergency broadcasts, weather delays and cancellations. Closure info is also located on the ACC website home page.

Travel decisions are the responsibility of each student after assessing the road conditions in their respective area, the condition of their vehicle and their driving skills. The College does not encourage students to take unnecessary risks in order to attend classes. If a student misses classes due to inclement weather, the student must notify the faculty member at the earliest possible time — preferably within 24 hours. Excused absence because of inclement weather is generally a matter between the student and instructor; the student should consult the instructor's syllabus for specific make-up work procedures.

# The Stephen H. Fletcher Library

Located in the Newport Center Building, the Library and A-V areas provide intellectual access to recorded knowledge and information consistent with the present and anticipated teaching and research responsibilities of Alpena Community College. The Alpena Community College academic library collection is generally most suitable for adult use; those obtaining library cards must be a student at ACC or its University Center, or be a non-student at least 18 years old.

The Library consists of books, pamphlets, periodicals, microforms, reference, CD and on-line materials. Computerized local and regional library catalogs and inter-library loan facsimile service give students, community patrons, and college staff quick access to materials anywhere in the country. Computerized (CD and on-line Internet) full-text access is available for over 10,000 unique periodical titles, The Detroit Free Press, and an assortment of other national and local newspapers. Computer access to the Internet, websites and e-mail, is also available in the ACC Library.

Audio-visual equipment is used primarily on campus at Alpena and at the Huron Shores Campus for instructional programs and for classroom use by individual students. Community groups holding meetings in college facilities may also request use of this equipment.

# Michigan Transfer Agreement

\*Replaces MACRAO Transfer Agreement Beginning Fall 2014

MACRAO Agreement for students who started prior to Fall 2014 Completion Deadline – Summer 2019 – see Registrar.

Alpena Community College participates in the Michigan Transfer Agreement between public and private community colleges and universities in Michigan. This agreement provides ACC students more assurance of having completed their general education requirements when they transfer to a participating four-year college or university. Working closely with your academic advisor is recommended to assure meeting MTA requirements. To fulfill the Michigan Transfer Agreement, students must successfully complete at least 30 credits, with at least a 2.0 in each course.

To be eligible for the Michigan Transfer Agreement at Alpena Community College, a minimum of 1 college level course must be taken at Alpena Community College. Transcripts of ACC graduates who meet the MTA requirements will automatically be certified for MTA when degrees are posted to academic records. Students who transfer prior to the completion of a degree program but have completed the MTA requirements may also be certified upon request. Requests should be made to the Registrar, 108 Van Lare Hall.

# Get a Head Start on College with **Dual Enrollment Courses**

Dual enrollment is a great way for high school students to earn college credits and take classes not offered by high schools. Under ACC's Dual Enrollment Program, eligible high school students may enroll in approved ACC classes and the local school district pays all tuition.

Alpena Community College encourages interested high school students and parents to contact their high school principal or guidance counselor for eligibility guidelines and dual enrollment information.

For a number of years Alpena Community College has also accepted enrollment by high school seniors who have a recommendation from the school principal or counselor but do not qualify for dual enrollment. Concurrently enrolled high school students are responsible for payment of all tuition and fees.

# **Admissions Policy**

Alpena Community College grants admission to all persons who have earned a high school Diploma, Certificate of Completion or GED, or who are 18 years of age or older, and who demonstrate the ability to benefit from a particular program of study. Ability to benefit may be demonstrated by those who:

- 1. Have satisfactory skills\* as measured by institutional placement testing for reading, language and numerical skills or
- 2. Can produce Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) test score results of 500 or better when coming from a non-English speaking country.

The age requirement is waived for a high school student who:

- 1. Is a dually enrolled high school student\* as provided for by the State School Aid Act, as amended, or
- 2. Is certified as having attained junior status toward graduation as determined by the high school or the home schooling association issuing the diploma. College course enrollment will be determined in accordance with the Alpena Community College ACCUPLACER placement test results for reading, language and numerical skills.
- \* Interested high school students should contact their high school principal or guidance counselor for further information.

This admissions policy applies to admission to the College only and is intended to assure students of both opportunity and quality in programs. Admission to a specific curriculum or course is based on student interest, achievement, and test scores necessary for preparation to enter a specific program or course.
