ALPENA COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND ACC FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

These scholarships have been created by individuals, service clubs, corporations, and foundations to provide financial assistance to the students of Alpena Community College. For your convenience, they are listed by course of study or other key categories.

A student who wishes to be considered for a specific scholarship must meet the qualifications and fill out the scholarship application form. An applicant must have a high school diploma or GED or demonstrate the ability to benefit from a particular program of study. Some scholarships require letters of recommendation and/or essays, and may be renewable for a second year provided all requirements are met.

Scholarship awards are applied to the student's account in equal amounts over the fall and spring semesters. If the scholarship recipient does not attend ACC for the fall semester, the scholarship award will be forfeited.

HOW TO APPLY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

- Apply for admission to Alpena Community College by completing admission forms obtained from either the ACC Admissions Office at Van Lare Hall or area high school counselors. Your application may also be completed online at www.alpenacc.edu. Click on "Future Students" and then "Apply."
- ◆ At the same time, apply for financial aid by completing financial aid forms available from the same sources as above.
 - Note: If applying for a scholarship where financial need must be demonstrated, results of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must be received by the ACC Financial Aid Office prior to the scholarship application deadline.
- Complete the ACC scholarship application form; include any required letters of recommendation and your high school or college transcript; indicate the scholarship(s) for which you are applying; and provide any other documentation required by the specific scholarship(s).

Please return a completed application form with appropriate attachments by March 20, 2017 to the ACC FINANCIAL AID OFFICE, 665 Johnson Street, Alpena, MI 49707.

Note: Dual-enrolled students do not qualify for scholarships.

NOTE: Scholarships with an icon () after their title require the submission of this application form plus additional information as indicated in the scholarship description.

TIPS FOR BECOMING A SUCCESSFUL SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

- 1. Read the application carefully and follow the directions.
- 2. The scholarship application form is usually the first document reviewed by selection committees. If you have illegible or messy handwriting, consider typing the application.
- Letters of recommendation may be required for some scholarships, and they are extremely important. Keep in mind that most individuals and instructors are quite busy and will need some time to develop a good letter of recommendation.
- 4. Take the initiative to find scholarship(s) that apply to you and be specific about which scholarships you are applying for.
- 5. Be sure to include all significant activities and honors received. Activities should represent varied talents and passions outside the classroom.
- 6. If essays are to be included, write clearly and follow the assigned topic. Also, applicants are encouraged to proofread and be sure to check spelling.
- 7. The last element in applying for a scholarship is getting it delivered on time. Before mailing, be sure to read through everything one more time to ensure that all of the necessary information is included.

ARTS

JUDITH DONALD MEMORIAL FINE ARTS SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student enrolled in the Fine Arts program on a full- or part-time basis. Preference will be given to individuals facing health challenges and/or unusual circumstances and students who have received their GED.

AVIS HINKS MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP 1

This \$200 scholarship is awarded to a full- or part-time student who is enrolled in at least one music theory, jazz ensemble, or music-related course. A letter of recommendation from a former music director and a short essay describing what music means to you and your future plans in music are required.

CLEM MASON FINE ARTS SCHOLARSHIP OF THE ALPENA LIONS CLUB MEMORIAL FOUNDATION

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a graduate of Alpena High School who is enrolled in one of the fine arts programs and has a minimum 2.0 GPA. This scholarship is renewable with a 2.0 GPA. Members of the Alpena Lions Club, their spouses, children and grandchildren are not eligible for this scholarship.

JILLIAN PAIGE SEGUIN SCHOLARSHIP

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a sophomore student enrolled full-time with a minimum 3.5 GPA, and who demonstrates community service and/or volunteer work as well as on-campus involvement.

BUD & DORIS STEWART SCHOLARSHIP

These \$1,000 scholarships are awarded to students enrolled full-time in ACC's Fine Arts Program or in a vocational or technical program. Candidates must have a minimum 3.0 GPA. First preference will be given to Fine Arts students. Financial need will be considered, but applicants do not have to be FAFSA eligible.

ALGER & NANCY ZAPF SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a full-time student pursuing a fine arts degree at ACC. Applicants must demonstrate financial need.

ATHLETICS

ALPENA BOOSTERS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to a male and female athlete enrolled on a full- or part-time basis in a certificate or degree program. Applicants must be graduating from Alpena High School where they played a varsity sport, have a minimum 2.0 GPA, and demonstrate financial need. Alpena Boosters Club members and their families are excluded.

STACY FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to students who are working toward an Associate in Applied Science Degree in Accounting or Business Management, or an Associate in Arts Degree with a concentration in Business Administration. Priority shall be given to candidates who intend to be involved in the College's athletic program as a student athlete while enrolled at ACC.

WILK FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to students enrolled in an occupational program of two years or less and demonstrate financial need. Priority shall be given to candidates who intend to be involved in the College's athletic program as a student athlete while enrolled at ACC.

Automotive

CLIFF ANSCHUETZ SCHOLARSHIP

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a student enrolled in the Automotive Service & Repair Program. Applicants must be graduates of Alpena High School. Financial need and the academic capability to be successful in the program must be demonstrated. Recipient must maintain an overall 2.5 GPA throughout the scholarship year.

BRADLEY T. HILBERG MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a full-time student enrolled in ACC's Auto Body Repair, Automotive Service & Repair, Preengineering or Concrete Technology programs. Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 GPA, live in Alpena or Alcona Counties, and demonstrate financial need

PETTALIA VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

Three scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$1,000 will be awarded to students enrolled in ACC's Auto Body or Automotive Service & Repair Programs. Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 GPA and live in the 106th District (Alpena, Alcona, Cheboygan, Iosco, or Presque Isle Counties)

BUD & DORIS STEWART SCHOLARSHIP — See "Arts"

KIM M. THOMPSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a graduate of Alcona High School who is enrolled in the Automotive Service & Repair, Auto Body or Concrete Technology programs and demonstrates academic promise.

Business

EDWARD ADAMS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to students who have graduated from a Northeast Michigan high school and are interested in studying banking or finance. Scholarships are renewable if a 3.0 or higher GPA is maintained.

BESSER COMPANY SCHOLARSHIP

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to full-time students who are pursuing a degree through the World Center for Concrete Technology, the Madeline Briggs University Center, or a university/college of their choice. Candidates must have a minimum 2.5 GPA. Preference will be given to students enrolled in the Concrete Technology, Nursing or a Business-related program, as well as employees of Besser Company or a concrete industry sponsor. A letter of recommendation is required.

BESSER CREDIT UNION SCHOLARSHIP

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to full-time students who are pursuing a degree in finance or a business-related program. Candidates must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and reside in Alpena, Alcona, Montmorency or Presque Isle County. Financial need is not a factor.

BONCZYK FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to full- or part-time students who are pursuing an Associate in Applied Science Degree in Business Management. Candidates must have a minimum 2.5 GPA and demonstrate financial need.

CREDIT UNIONS OF ALPENA SCHOLARSHIP 1

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a full- or part-time student who is pursuing a degree in the field of business or finance.

Applicants must be a member of one of the Credit Unions of Alpena and provide documentation with their application. A minimum 2.5 GPA is required and financial need is not a factor.

ESI INDUSTRIAL SALES SCHOLARSHIP

These scholarships are awarded to students who are pursuing an Associates Degree in Industrial Sales, participating in an ESI-sponsored mentorship, and intending to achieve a career as an industrial sales professional. The scholarship amount is renewable and varies. Applicants must contact Brian VanWormer at (989) 358-7190.

JAMES & BETTY MASTERS SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded a full-time student who is pursuing a degree in any business-related program. Applicants must be from Alpena County and have a minimum 2.5 GPA.

DOREEN MCCLAY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

These \$1,000 scholarships are awarded to students who are pursuing a career in business administration or management program.

MOUILSO SCHOLARSHIP

This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a non-traditional, full-time student enrolled in ACC's business or nursing program. Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 GPA.

ROBERT E. MUNROE SCHOLARSHIP FOR ENTREPRENEURIAL STUDY 1

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a full- or part-time student accepted into the Small Business Management Program. Interested applicants must submit an essay explaining their plans for the future and their interest in owning and operating a small business. A 3.0 GPA and one letter of reference is also required.

CARL & HELEN PATZER SCHOLARSHIP

This \$200 scholarship is awarded to a Northeast Michigan high school graduate who is pursuing a career in the natural sciences (including ornithology or field biology), business, or utility technology. A 2.5 GPA or higher is required and financial need will be considered. Priority will be given to relatives of Carl and Helen Patzer. The scholarship may be used for tuition or toward a legitimate field project approved by an instructor from the ACC Science Department.

STACY FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP — See "Athletics"

XLT CORP. SCHOLARSHIP |

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a part-time, non-traditional student in business or any technical program. An essay describing past education, work history and skills, community involvement, and plans for the future must be submitted, as well as a letter of recommendation supporting the student's education and career aspirations. Financial need is a factor, and a minimum 3.0 GPA is required.

CAD/CAM CNC Technology

RUDY BAUER SCHOLARSHIP | 1

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student who is pursuing a degree or certificate in Computer-aided Drafting & Design Technology, Manufacturing Technology, or a career in CAD Technology or Engineering. The scholarship will be awarded to a full- or part-time student who resides in Alpena, Alcona, Montmorency, or Presque Isle County. Applicants must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and submit two letters of recommendation. A

minimum 2.5 GPA must be maintained to receive the scholarship for the spring semester.

ALAN BEITLER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP 1

This \$500 scholarship sponsored by Bay Mfg. Corp. is awarded to a student who is pursuing a certificate or degree program in Computer-Aided Drafting & Design Technology or Manufacturing Technology, or a career in CAD Technology or Engineering. Applicants must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and submit two letters of recommendation. School and community involvement will be considered.

KRIS DAVID DZIESINSKI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$200 scholarship is awarded to a freshman student who is pursuing a degree in Computer-Aided Drafting & Design Technology. Candidates must be a graduating senior from Alpena High School and have a minimum 3.0 GPA.

ESI DRAFTING/DESIGN SCHOLARSHIP

These scholarships are awarded to students who are pursuing degrees in Computer-Aided Drafting & Design Technology or pre-engineering, participating in an ESI-sponsored mentorship, and intending to achieve a career in CAD technology. These renewable scholarships will range from \$125 to \$500 per semester based upon cumulative GPA. Applicants must contact Brian VanWormer at (989) 358-7190 if interested.

MICHAEL GORDON GRAY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student who is pursuing a degree in Engineering, Computer Science, or Computer Information Systems. Applicants must demonstrate financial need and have strong math and science skills.

GENE HAAS SCHOLARSHIP

These \$1,000 scholarships, provided by the Gene Haas Foundation, are awarded to recent high school graduates who are pursuing CNC machinist-based training or a Manufacturing Engineering program with an emphasis on CNC machining. Applicants must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and be enrolled as a full-time student at ACC.

DONALD HUDAK CAD/CAM TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a freshman student from Presque Isle County who is pursuing a certificate or degree in CAD/CAM CNC Technology. Candidates must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and submit high school transcripts. A letter of recommendation from a high school instructor is preferred.

DALE ILSLEY CAD/CAM TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a freshman student who is pursuing a certificate or degree in CAD/CAM CNC Technology. Candidates must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and submit high school transcripts. A letter of recommendation from a high school instructor is preferred.

CONCRETE TECHNOLOGY

BESSER COMPANY SCHOLARSHIP 1 — See "Business"

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student enrolled in any trades program at ACC (Concrete Technology, Utility Technology, Welding). Applicants must be a resident of Alpena County, and financial need is not a factor.

DALE T. & JUDITH L. DEAN SCHOLARSHIP

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to full- or part-time freshman students entering the Concrete Technology Program who have an interest in a career in the masonry production industry. A minimum 2.0 GPA must be maintained.

JAMES A. DONAJKOWSKI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a full-time student accepted into the Concrete Technology Program who demonstrates academic promise and dedication to the program.

ROBERT H. & DOROTHY A. DOYLE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a freshman or sophomore student in Concrete Technology who demonstrates a commitment to the program and initiative in the classroom.

CRIMINAL JUSTICE/LAW ENFORCEMENT

SHERIFF DUANE A. BADDER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$200 scholarship is awarded to an active law enforcement officer or second-year law enforcement student. Priority is given to residents or employees of Presque Isle County. The award could go to a part-time student if he or she is currently a law enforcement officer. A minimum 2.0 GPA is required.

GERALD L. CARPENTER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a graduate of Alpena High School who is majoring in law enforcement or criminal justice. Candidate must have a minimum 2.5 GPA. This scholarship is renewable if recipient maintains at least a 2.5 GPA. Financial need is not a factor.

BRYON S. EGELSKI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP 1

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to sophomores majoring in criminal justice and have graduated from a high school in Alcona, Alpena, losco, Montmorency, or Presque Isle County. Candidates must possess a minimum overall 2.0 GPA and maintain a minimum overall 2.5 GPA throughout the scholarship year. A letter indicating why you chose criminal justice is also required.

TROOPER LARRY FORREIDER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a sophomore student who has successfully completed his/her freshman year at ACC, is majoring in law enforcement, and has graduated from a school in Alcona, Alpena, Montmorency, or Presque Isle County. Applicants must demonstrate good citizenship, public service, and moral integrity.

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to students who are beginning their sophomore year in the law enforcement program and who reside in Alpena, Alcona, Presque Isle, or Montmorency County. Applicants must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and have an expressed interest in becoming a police officer. A cover letter is required stating why the applicant is interested in receiving a scholarship. Financial need is not a factor.

HAGOP "JAKE" KUREDJIAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to full-time students from Michigan who are pursuing an associate's degree in criminal justice or law enforcement. Candidates must have a minimum 2.75 GPA and demonstrate good citizenship and moral integrity.

STUART LOZON CRIMINAL JUSTICE SCHOLARSHIP OF THE ALPENA LIONS CLUB MEMORIAL FOUNDATION

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a student enrolled in ACC's Criminal Justice or Law Enforcement programs. The student must be a graduate of Alpena High School and have a minimum 2.0 GPA. This scholarship is renewable for a second year if the recipient maintains a 2.0 GPA. Members of the Alpena Lions Club, their spouse, children and grandchildren are not eligible.

ROBERT L. SCHULKE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to students who are cancer survivors or have an immediate family member that is a cancer survivor, or has passed away due to cancer. Special consideration will be given to those students enrolled in a health occupations

or law enforcement program. Candidates must be a resident of Alpena County, enrolled at ACC for a minimum of six credit hours per semester, and maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA.

DEPUTY RYAN SEGUIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP 🗇

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a sophomore student pursuing a degree in criminal justice or law enforcement. Candidates must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and live in Alpena, Alcona, Montmorency, Presque Isle or losco County. An essay is required describing why the candidate feels he/she is deserving of this scholarship. Preference will be given to applicants from Alpena County.

TERESA A. SZYMANSKI SCHOLARSHIP

This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a student who is enrolled in ACC's Criminal Justice or Law Enforcement program. Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 GPA and have participated in extra-curricular activities or community service. Preference will first be given to female students and then to any student from Alpena County. Financial need is not a factor.

GARY TOMASZEWSKI— ALPENA AREA F.O.P. SCHOLARSHIP 🗇

This \$350 scholarship is awarded to a student from Northeast Michigan who is pursuing a certificate or degree in criminal justice or law enforcement. Applicants must possess a minimum 2.0 GPA, demonstrate good citizenship, and submit a cover letter stating why they are interested in receiving a scholarship.

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a full- or part-time student who is pursuing a career in special education and has a minimum 3.0 GPA.

This \$200 scholarship is awarded to a full- or part-time student from Montmorency County who is pursuing a career in education.

O. B. & EVELYN EUSTIS ENVIRONMENTAL SCHOLARSHIP

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to students pursuing a career in environmental science or education and have demonstrated active involvement in environmental activities. The award may be used for tuition or towards an environmental project approved by an ACC instructor. This \$2,500 scholarship is awarded to a full-time student pursuing a career as an elementary education teacher.

ERNESTINE M. JASKEY TEACHER'S SCHOLARSHIP

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a full- or part-time student enrolled in a certificate or degree program who is pursuing a career in education. A minimum 3.0 GPA is required.

ROBERT W. & ILA C. JONES EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student majoring in education. Awards are based on academic merit and financial need.

JEAN MARTINDALE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a resident of Alpena County who is pursuing a career in elementary education.

DEE NEWPORT FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a female student pursuing a degree in elementary education. Candidates must participate in ACC athletics.

MARIETTA BOLDREY PEWOSKI SCHOLARSHIP

This \$300 scholarship is awarded to a part- or full-time student who is a graduating senior from Hillman High School. Priority is given to those pursuing a degree in education. Extra-curricular activities and community service will be considered.

Engineering

ACC ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP

Up to \$1,250 is awarded to a student who is pursuing a degree in engineering or a related field and has demonstrated high academic potential as a dual-enrolled student.

FRANK AGIUS FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a student who attended Alpena High School for four years, graduated from AHS, and is enrolled full time in ACC's pre-engineering program. Candidates must also have a minimum 3.0 GPA.

Recipients must be enrolled at ACC for a minimum of 6 credit hours per semester and maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA. Special consideration will be given to those students in the health occupations field.

NANCY & MIKE DESROCHER NURSING SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to an ACC second-year nursing student who has demonstrated a genuine caring personality as judged by his or her nursing instructors and is deemed a dedicated student with an above-average work ethic. GPA is not a consideration.

EDUCATED AND TO SERVE LOCALLY: HEALTHCARE HUMAN SERVICES SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a full- or part-time student pursuing a degree or certificate in a human medicine healthcare

program. Applicants must reside within Alpena, Alcona, Oscoda, Presque Isle or Montmorency County and possess a high school diploma or GED, receiving a minimum 2.8 GPA. The recipient must maintain at least a 2.8 overall semester GPA to be eligible for the scholarship for spring semester. These scholarship award amounts vary (\$250-\$500). Students must be enrolled full-time in ACC's Nursing Program, successfully complete the Level I program, and be admitted into the Level II program. The following will be considered when making the award determination: the student communicates well and teaches patients at the bedside; displays eagerness to perform every patient-care procedure; is enthusiastic and demonstrates a positive, caring attitude; is prepared with information needed to carry out the tasks to complete each shift; and helps and supports nursing classmates. Students will be selected by the nursing faculty so there is no application to submit.

ROBERT & DOLORES KANNOWSKI MEMORIAL NURSING SCHOLARSHIP

These \$250 scholarships are awarded to full-time Level I or Level II (semester 1) nursing students. Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 GPA. Preference will be given to those from Alpena County and the surrounding areas and those demonstrating the greatest financial need

JANICE A KOLLIEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$300 scholarship is awarded to a Level II nursing student who is pursuing a Registered Nursing degree.

SARA KRAA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a full-time student enrolled in the Level I (LPN) Nursing Program at ACC. Applicants must have a minimum 3.5 GPA. These \$500 scholarships are awarded to students enrolled in the Registered Nursing program at ACC. Candidates must be from the family of a veteran to be eligible.

This \$300 scholarship is awarded to a full-time student from Alpena County who is accepted into the Level I Licensed Practical Nursing program. Academic performance and financial need will be considered, with preference given to students who demonstrate the commitment and compassion for caring for the sick and suffering. Candidates must submit an essay explaining their interest in becoming a nurse.

JO ANN PEARSALL MEMORIAL NURSING SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a full-time student from Alpena or Alcona County who is accepted into ACC's nursing program. Candidates must have a minimum 3.0 GPA, show academic promise and demonstrate financial need. Students pursuing a career in the fields of natural or environmental science will also be considered if there are no nursing students who meet the above selection criteria.

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student accepted into ACC's nursing program who demonstrates financial need.

This \$150 renewable scholarship is awarded to a graduate of Alpena High School who is majoring in biology or natural resources, who demonstrate financial need, and who have a 2.0 or higher GPA.
