

City of Belton and Waste Management Scholarship Application

A \$2,000 scholarship is available to a graduating high school senior living in the Belton city limits and attending a Belton High School, home school program, or private school.

Eligibility:

1. Applicant must be a Belton graduating senior.
2. Applicant must reside within the City of Belton, TX boundaries and be a citizen of the United States.
3. Applicant must be able to verify admission to a two-year or four-year college or university or accredited trade school or technical school (submit copy of acceptance letter, SAT and/or ACT scores, or applicable entrance test).
4. Applicant must be committing to full-time college status (minimum of 12 hours per semester).
5. Applicant must submit this completed application and requested attachments to the school counselor's office by the deadline date. Under no circumstances will any late applications be considered.

Instructions:

1. Application must be complete to be considered (see checklist below).
2. Please type or print clearly.
3. Attach the following to the completed application:
 - Application form
 - Applicant's 500-word (or less) essay – Promoting environmental awareness in the community
 - Teacher/counselor recommendation form
 - Letter of recommendation (should not come from someone at school or from a family member, No more than two)
 - Copy of college acceptance letters and/or scholarship award letters. Copy of unofficial high school transcript, SAT, and/or ACT test scores (or applicable entrance test).

Deadline for Submission: May 12, 2017, of your senior year of high school. TURN IN TO HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR or at Belton City Hall.

No more than two letters should be submitted per applicant, and no letter should exceed two pages in length.
