#### **REGULAR AGENDA:**

Mayor O'Dwyer welcomed everyone to today's Work Session and Interim City Manager Eshman provided an overview and objectives for today's meeting.

Public Works Director Derrick Schueller gave a review of "Where are we now: Roads and Water" from the PowerPoint presentation.

Finance Director/Treasurer David Sabuda gave a review of the "Capital Financing" from the PowerPoint presentation.

Public Works Director Derrick Schueller gave a review of the "Proposed Hybrid Sidewalk Program" from the PowerPoint presentation.

Assistant City Manager Darchelle Strickland Love gave a review of "Establishing Priorities" in the PowerPoint presentation. Priorities for Roads and Water recommendation is option 2 at \$11,852,529 for road and water main construction. This includes asphalt in residential area, concrete on main roads, and five to seven half mile sections plus more aggressive concrete patching. Road and Water Financing Preferences and Timing recommendation is a bond proposal at \$11,852,529, for May 2017 election, and will not include Harvard Road.

Priorities for Municipal Buildings are as following:

1. Public Safety will need less than \$581,849 for repairs, estimated cost at \$200,000 or less.

- 2. Library will need less than \$35,155 for repairs with no major repairs and HVAC needs replacement in 2 years.
- 3. City Hall complex will need \$1,688,000 and Historic Fire House will need \$1,913,000. Administration needs to identify cost for redesign of both buildings or pursue an alternative.
- 4. Public Works will need \$469,250 for the Salt Dome replacement which can be postponed for 2 years; some minor repairs have been completed.
- 5. Community Center will need \$145,716 in which \$100,000 for the east and south wall repair, parking lot repairs, and fencing repairs across from tennis court off of Robina.
- 6. Ice Arena will need \$5,935,000 in which \$2.3 million will be needed for locker room updates, fire suppression, paint and coiling repairs, HVAC, roof, parking lot and new refrigerant system.

Paul Kalomiris, Deputy Director for the National Council for Public Private Partnerships (NCPPP) provided everyone with a Public-Private Partnership (P3) handout.
