When she first came to Bethel in 1936 the school had 48 pupils, compared to a current enrollment of over 900.

Her husband, Dr. T. J. Hanberry, is Dean of Academics at Benedict College and has served as Acting President for the past two years.

Mr. Havird said, "Mrs. Hanberry richly deserves this honor. She has been a dedicated educator and has had a wonderful influence on the lives of the pupils and teachers who have had the privilege of an association with her.

"We congratulate Mrs. Hanberry and look forward to her continued service with us in Hanberry High School, as well as Bethel Elementary School."
