**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLEGE PLACE, WASHINGTON REGARDING ALLOCATING AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT GRANT FUNDS.**

**Whereas**, the City of College Place is a non-charter code city governed by the rules and regulations of RCW 35A; and

**Whereas**, the Congress of the United States adopted the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 on March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021; and

**Whereas**, aide to local governments was included within this package; and

**Whereas**, based on the fact the City is not a direct recipient community, grant funds are flowing through the State Office of Financial Management (OFM); and

**Whereas**, the College Place City Council accepted the grant contract via Agenda Bill 21-135 during its June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2021 City Council meeting; and

**Now therefore, it is hereby resolved by the City Council of the City of College Place, Washington, as follows:**

1. The City Council directs the City Administrator and the management team to pursue allocation of funds based on the proposed allocation spreadsheet and installment deviation.

**Clerical Corrections.** The City Clerk is authorized to make necessary clerical corrections to this resolution including, but not limited to, the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, resolution numbering, section/subsection numbers and any references thereto.

**Effective Date.** This resolution shall take effect and be in full force upon its passage as provided by law.
