## SHIPPING CONTAINERS IN CURRY COUNTY

Shipping containers can be placed on your property for storage, but a Planning Clearance is required.

Planning Clearance applications will be reviewed to confirm the container meets setback and planning requirements.



Curry County Planning requires shipping containers to be painted (to remove lettering) and landscaped (to create a visual screen). Paint colors should blend into the surrounding environment. Tan, light brown or shades of green to match nearby vegetation are usually good choices.





Shipping containers used for storage and less than 200 square feet in size do not require a building permit. Anchoring of a shipping container is not required, but it is recommended.

Shipping containers are not made for living in. Modification of containers intended for residential use must meet Oregon Building Code standards and require Building Permits.
