Renewal of Current five-year Local Option Levy for Fire Operations

Question 20 words which plainly phrases the chief purpose of the measure.

Shall District impose \$1.375 per \$1000 of assessed value for fire supression and operations for five years beginning 2022-2023? This measure renews current local option taxes.

Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

This measure, proposed by the elected Sixes Fire Protection District Board, continues an expiring Local Option Levy at it's current rate. Sixes Fire has one of the lowest assessed fire district general funds in Oregon at .51 per \$1000. Without the proposed continued funding, insurance rates plus operating costs will not allow continued operation beyond 2022 and district tax payer structure/building insurance rates may increase. If the renewal is voter approved the Fire District will be able to sustain emergency first responders, rescue, motor vehicle accident and fire service. Sixes Fire is dispatched by 911 covering 42 square miles, 34 million in home, school and farm property value. The proposed rate will raise approximately, \$48,577 in 2022-2023, \$50,034 in 2023-2024, \$51,535 in 2024-2025, \$53,081 in 2025-2026, \$54,674 in 2026-2027, for a total of \$257,901
