

DTE Energy is Upgrading Natural Gas Infrastructure



Traverse City - Alpena Reinforcement Project

Objective: Increase reliability of the natural gas system
serving Northern Michigan

Project Facts:

- Installing approximately 22 miles of new natural gas pipeline in two phases that will provide redundancy to two existing pipelines
 - Phase-1 Garfield Township to Blair Township – 2020 Construction
 - Phase-2 Blair Township to Inland Township – 2021 Construction
- Supported by the Michigan Public Service Commission (MPSC) because the project increases the reliability of the natural gas system in Northern Michigan
- Total Investment by DTE of approximately \$80 million

Overall Project Benefits:

- Improve service reliability to approximately 91,000 DTE customers in Northern Michigan
- Adds a second supply source to the area to help minimize customer service interruptions during routine pipeline maintenance or in the unlikely event of an emergency
- Increases annual tax revenue for local communities and area school districts
