CHAPTER 73-2. OUTDOOR SALES

- 7.100. <u>License Required</u>. It shall be unlawful for any person, regardless of whether that person is required to have obtained another license by the City, to sell outside that person's business establishment, whether on a public or non-public sidewalk, grassy area or in a parking area, any product or service other than what that person sells inside his/her business establishment unless that person has received from the City a license authorizing an outdoor sale of products or services other than products or services sold inside that establishment.
- 7.101. <u>License Application.</u> Any person seeking to obtain a license pursuant to this Chapter shall pay an administrative fee and file an application with the City Clerk upon forms prescribed and furnished by the Clerk.
- 7.102. Penalty. Violation of this Chapter is hereby designated a municipal civil infraction and a civil fine in an amount not to exceed \$500.00 plus costs shall be paid by a defendant who is found responsible for each such violation. Violators shall also be subject to sanctions, remedies and procedures as set forth in Chapter 6 of this City Code and Act No. 236 of the Michigan Public Acts of 1961, as amended.
