CHAPTER 74. CARNIVALS AND CIRCUSES

- 7.121. <u>License Required.</u> It shall be unlawful for any person to operate or maintain within the City, a carnival, or circus, unless the owner, licensee, or person in possession thereof has obtained from the City a license to operate the same and has displayed said license in a prominent place on the premises.
- 7.122. <u>Application</u>. Application shall be made on a form furnished by the City Clerk which shall set forth the owner's name, address and the type and amount of liability insurance carried and the name of the insurance carrier. Applicant shall also state the place within the City where the applicant proposes to carry on his entertainment.
- 7.123. <u>License Fee.</u> Every licensee hereunder shall pay the inspection, regulation and license fee as established in Chapter 72.
- 7.124. <u>Approval.</u> No license hereunder shall be issued except on certification by the Chief of Police. Location of any carnival, or circus type of entertainment shall be subject to the approval of the City Manager.
- 7.125. <u>Violation; Municipal Civil Infraction.</u> A person who violates any provision of this Chapter is responsible for a municipal civil infraction, subject to payment of a civil fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00, plus costs and other sanctions, for each violation. Repeat offenses shall be subject to increased fines as provided by Section 1.12(3)(b) of this Code. The City Manager is hereby designated as the authorized City official to issue municipal civil infraction citations (directing alleged violators to appear in court) or municipal civil infraction violation notices (directing alleged violators to appear at the City of Frankenmuth Municipal Ordinance Violations Bureau) for violations under this Chapter as provided by this Code.
