State police will be adding 100 new deputies in the next year state wide. Letter read from Enbridge regarding the new pipeline that will go through some of the township. Ordinance Enforcement Officer: Vehicle at 11284 Hieber has been removed. One call about Pleasant Lake Inn, the noise, the windows were open.

Clerk report: The audit has been wrapped up, gearing up for the August 7<sup>th</sup> election.
