

FREEDOM TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION
REGULAR MEETING
OCT. 5, 2004

Chairman Tschiltz called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Minutes of the September 7, 2004 meeting were read and approved.

Communications: Letter of Credit for C & T Materials, Semcog and Huron River Report. A letter was received from John Etter noting that the consent judgment has not been signed by Levy Company yet.

Agenda Item I – Review of first amended Consent Judgment. It was noted that the amended Consent Judgment adequately portrayed what the Planning Commission had wanted.

Agenda Item II – Levy Company Representatives Dale Sawyer and Timothy Higbee went over their explanation of the restoration plan they had previously submitted. They estimate an approximate 15 year time plan. After lengthy discussion it was decided there needs to be some additional work done on the map. They were going to take care of it and would come back to our next meeting if necessary.

Agenda Item III – Report from Richard Schenk that was given to the Secretary was that Bud Scherdt figures he has taken out 300 to 400 yards of dirt this year. His intention is to level off the hill and build a barn. We will continue to monitor this.
