Public Hearing called to order by Chairman Lindemann at 7:05 p.m.

Roll Call: DeLoof, Horning, Huehl, Lindemann and Ochs. DeLoof made motion to open hearing with support from Horning. Motion passed.

A Public Hearing notice was publicized twice April 12 and April 19 and posted at the Township Hall as of April 12, 2007.

Public Comment: A person stated that he felt copies should be available to the public at the hearing. Don Pennington went over Article 13.0 on Administration and Enforcement. These changes are all mandated by the State to meet their requirements. He's putting everything in one area to make it easier and understandable for everyone.

A motion was made by DeLoof with support from Horning to close the Public hearing. No discussion followed. Motion passed by roll call vote.

Horning made a motion with support from DeLoof to open the Planning Commission meeting. Motion passed by roll call vote.

DeLoof made a motion to recommend to the Township Board to adopt the Zoning Ordinance Revisions as presented. Horning supported. No discussion followed. Motion passed by roll call vote.

DeLoof made a motion with support from Horning to adjourn. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 7:23 p.m.
