

FREEDOM TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION
Public Hearing for Washtenaw County Parks
August 12, 2010

Members present: Peter DeLoof, Carol Huehl, Larry Lindemann, Susan Ochs, and Dan Schaible

A motion was made by Ochs to open the Public Hearing with support from Huehl. Motion passed. The Public Hearing began at 7:00p.m.

Richard Kent gave an overview of what the Washtenaw County Parks and Recreation wanted to do. Their intention was to expand 39 acres to the Brauer Preserve.

Robert Gross wants a fence.

Richard Roehm said the North East side of his property line and the South side of his property does not need a fence nor does he want one.

If the Property owners request fencing at a later date it would be permitted.

Charles Hieber works the farm across Parker Road and asked about the plugged drainage tiles and that the water was backing up on his property.

Need to find out if it's a County drain or not. If it's not a County drain the Parks will work with him to resolve the problem.

Ken Hieber noted that at the parking lot entrance the brush needs to be trimmed back further for sight distance.

Charles Hieber noted that the wildlife was out of hand – lots of deer - geese and turkeys.

Larry Lindemann said the current conditional use does not allow hunting.

There was no further discussion.

DeLoof with support from Schaible made a motion to close the public hearing. Motion passed. Public Hearing closed at 7:25p.m.
