Chairman Lindemann called the hearing to order at 7:40 p.m.

Planner Rodney Nanney was also in attendance.

A motion was made by Little with support from Schaible to open the public hearing.

Rodney Nanney – stated that this document was the result of a substantial amount of discussions and meetings. It was sent out to other entities for their input. The Planning Commission members should be commended for their work on it. This is a solid document for the future.

Karen Flahie – Complimented the Planning Commission members for a job well done. She feels that the language isn't real good about some of the ordinances regarding the lake and its uniqueness. She would like to see these issues looked at. She feels the Master Plan is written much better this time.

Larry Lindemann – explained he wanted to work on Keyhole ordinance and get it updated first. The committee for this will be set up at a later date. The committee size would probably be three people. This will be put on the January agenda.

Carol Westfall – thanked the Planning Commission for the effort they put into this. On page 1-4 the 3rd bullet she would like to have lakes included. On page 9-5 she asked if this should be changed as Pleasant Lake Inn no longer exists. On page 13-2 #6 she asked about wind turbines and if they could be put on residential property.

Larry Lindemann – explained that the wind turbines are addressed in our Zoning Ordinance.

After no more questions or discussions the Public Hearing was adjourned at 7:55p.m.
