**Overview by planner:**

The proposed Zoning Ordinance amendments were intended to supplement the licensing requirement and standards contained in the recently adopted Short-Term Transient Rental Ordinance No. 50. The Zoning Ordinance amendments would insert short-term transient rentals as allowable land uses in certain zoning districts and add corresponding definitions and a reference to the new Ordinance No. 50.
