Navitrol (Triclopyr) & 2, 4-D (Navigate): Do not use treated water for irrigation for the posted amount of time after application. As an alternative to waiting the number of specified days, treated water may be used for irrigation once the concentration level in the treatment area is determined to be safe as determined by laboratory analysis or approximately 3 weeks after treatment.
