Rules & Regulations:



Safety Requirements:

- * Participants must be at least 8 years old to participate.
- * No more than 2 racers per sled.
- * All racers must wear a helmet.
- * All racers in sled must be in the same age division

Competitions- Most Creative & Fastest Sled

- Registration will start the day of the event at 10:30 am unless you are pre-registered. Sled inspection will take place near starting line and RRN trailer.
- * Each competition consists of an adult division (13 and older), a child division (12 and under) and a Business Division.
- * The Creative Sled Contest will be held slope side at 11:30 am. All sleds participating in this competition must be registered before 11:30 am to qualify.
- * The race will be held slope side, at 12:00 pm. Participants are responsible for their sled at all times. Racers must transport the sled up the race hill.
- No pushing or jumping at the start line. Racers must sit in sled.
- * Racers will compete with their division. The fastest sled in each heat will advance to the next race. Heats will continue until 3 sleds remain. The top three sleds will receive awards.

Rules

- Sleds must be constructed of standard brown cardboard (no waxed) and duct tape only! Sleds containing any other constructive materials (wood, nails, metal, etc.) will be disqualified.
- * Sleds may be decorated and painted. The base of the sled must be duct tape or standard brown cardboard. Waxed cardboard, paint, glue, other tape, plastic, etc. will not be allowed.
- * Sleds must be free of sharp or point objects. Any sled that questions the safety of the rider or audience will be asked to alter the sled of will be disqualified.
- * All sleds will be inspected for compliance of rules at registration and then again at the start line.
- * Participants will be given the opportunity to fix a violation at registration only! If a violation is detected at the start line, the sled will be disqualified from the event.
- Racers are responsible for sled disposal after race.

Registration

- * Pre-Registering is recommended. Registration forms can be found online at www.gladstonemi.org, and can be dropped off at City Hall. Registration fee is \$10. Or register on Saturday, February 19th, from 10:30 am 11:30 am at slope side near the Lodge.
- * Completed sled and all participants must be registered and inspected prior to the event and must meet requirements as outlined above.
- Again, sleds that still require alteration at the start line will be disqualified from the event.
- * A Release and Waiver from Liability form must be completed and signed by each racer/parent/guardian prior to the race
