2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE AUGUST 22, 2012 MEETING

The minutes of the August 22, 2012 meeting were approved with a motion by Member Alexander, Second by Member Bhote.

4. OPEN MEETING ACT TRAINING

Mike Volling reminded the HRF members in attendance that Illinois State Law requires them to complete Open Meeting Act Training. It can be completed on-line, but must be done before December. An email reminder with the link to the on-line Attorney General Training will be sent to all HRF members.

5. VEHICLE STICKER CONTEST

Applications for the annual vehicle sticker contest are being distributed to the Glencoe Schools. The completed submissions are due October 15. Member Flanagin will pick them up on October 16, and they will be reviewed by the HRF at the October 17 meeting. A winner will be chosen that night.

6. THANKSGIVING TURKEY DRIVE

Glencoe Golf Course Manager Stella Nanos stated she would work with the HRF to host the Turkey Drive. A couple of possible dates were discussed but it appears November 11 will work best. Chairperson Cogan will contact Stella and confirm if that date works for the Golf Course.

Discussion was held on what kind of “turkey targets” would be used, how big they should be, how many will be put out, and where they would be obtained. Oriental Trading company had some good prices and that will be looked into. Grace Kapsimalis offered to assist with the program. It was determined she could best use her documented, award winning talents by putting her in charge of crafts for the Turkey Drive.

All details for the event have not yet been finalized. The possibility of charging a \$1 a ball or a flat fee for a bucket of balls was discussed. It was agreed golfers should be observed as they drive the ball to make sure we know which ball hits the target in the event multiple golfers are competing at the same time. Money from the event will go to either a food pantry or turkeys will be donated in the name of the golfer. Still trying to determine what it would cost to purchase turkeys and whether or not doing so is feasible. The event will take place “rain or shine”. Members will place posters around town in an effort to advertise the event once details are worked out. There was concern that a Bears Football game scheduled for November 11 might conflict with the event and reduce the number of participants; however, the game that day is scheduled for 7:30 PM. Holding the event between the hours of 1 PM – 3 PM would allow Bear fans to participate. No such discussion was held regarding the Packers.

7. OTHER BUSINESS

Chairperson Cogan has received information from a Glencoe resident that is interested in joining the HRF. Her name has been submitted to Village President Scott Feldman for consideration and she might be appointed at the September 20 Village Board Meeting.
