The Fourteenth meeting of the Sustainability Working Group (SWG) was called to order at 7:08 p.m. in the Conference Room at Village Hall. The following members were present: Chairman Walt Eckenhoff, Beth Dunn, Jean Hahn, Hall Healy, Laurie Morse, Mark Piltingsrud, Larry Smith, and Community Development Analyst Nathan Parch. Members Andre Lerman and Dudley Onderdonk were absent.

# REPORTS FROM SUBCOMMITTEES

- A. <u>PILOT PROJECT</u> Members continued planning for the Buckthorn Barbeque an event to benefit local organization Friends of the Green Bay Trail led by resident Betsy Leibsen. It was agreed that the event will take place from 7:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 18<sup>th</sup> at the Glencoe Golf Club. Catering details will be finalized by Jean Hahn.
