Permit Fee (Permit fees are not prorated and are not transferable.)

- Standard Residential: \$50
- Senior Residential: \$25 (primary resident of the property is 65 years or older)
 *Proof of age required for new residences and current residents moving from the standard classification to senior.
- Non-Residential/Business: \$50

Payment Responsibility

Public Safety responds to all alarms, whether the alarm is for a legitimate emergency or not. As such, in addition to an annual alarm permit fee, the Village charges fees for false alarms. The schedule is based upon the number of false alarms during a calendar year. Contact the Public Safety non-emergency number at (847) 835-4112 within 15 days of receiving your quarterly notices to request a waiver of any service charge.

Payment Methods and Details

- Bills may be paid online, by mail, via night deposit box at Village Hall or in-person at Village Hall.
- Pay online with Credit Card Go to www.villageofglencoe.org/pay to pay by Visa or Master Card (no convenience fee).
- Non-sufficient funds (NSF) payments are \$35 per transaction. Late payments result in a 10% late penalty.
- Permit fees are not prorated or transferrable
- If you longer have an active alarm system, it is your responsibility to notify the Village of Glencoe in writing at finance@villageofglencoe.org. You will continue to be charged for alarm services until written communication is received by the Village.

Payment must be received (not postmarked) by 4:30 p.m. of the due date to avoid a late payment charge. Postdated checks are not held for deposit. Please allow seven working days for mail delivery. Payments placed in the Village white mailbox are retrieved at 8 a.m., Monday through Friday. Any payment placed in the white mailbox after this time will not be applied until the following business day. Failure to receive bill does not exempt customer from penalty charges.
