50/50 PARKWAY & PRIVATE TREE PLANTING PROGRAM APPLICATION 2016**

Each year the Village shares the cost of planting parkway trees with interested residents through the annual tree planting program. Beginning in 1996, trees were offered for planting on private property as well. While the resident bears the full cost and an additional planting fee for private property planting, you will find that the prices are still very competitive. In general, any of the trees offered this year should be planted no closer than 25 feet to any other tree and no closer than 10 feet to any structures. The trees will be planted in November by Mike Greco, of Gurnee, IL. There is a 2 year guarantee on all trees. Note that the program offers 2½", 3" and 4" diameter trees. The attached price list shows the cost of parkway and private planting of the various species and sizes.

DONATE A TREE – If your parkway is full or unsuitable for planting, you may want to consider donating a tree for another public right-of-way location. You can suggest a location or leave that decision to Village staff. In either case, Village staff will handle the details. Call 835-4111 extension 1118 for more information or for questions on the program. The prices shown are the total cost to the resident for planting, initial mulch and two-year guarantee.

Step 7 - Your check will be held until our staff has reviewed the application. If there is a concern over your proposed location or the species, you will be notified. If there are no problems, the application and check will be processed. Planting will occur in the mid to late fall.

The Village of Glencoe prides itself on receiving Tree City USA awards for the past 20 years. The Tree City program promotes planting and care in urban areas and calls attention to the economic, health, and aesthetic benefits that trees offer. To be eligible, a community must designate someone to be responsible for its urban forest program, have a community tree ordinance, spend \$2 per resident for its tree program, enact an Arbor Day proclamation and hold a public tree planting ceremony. Tree City USA is annually sponsored by the National Arbor Day Foundation, in cooperation with the Department of Natural Resources, the National Association of State Foresters and the U.S.D.A. Forest Service.

DONATE A TREE - If your parkway is full or unsuitable for planting, consider donating a tree for another public right-of-way location. You can suggest a location or leave that decision to Village Staff. In either case, Village Staff will handle the details. Call 835-4111, x 1118 for more information or for questions on the program. The prices shown below are the total cost to the resident for planting, plastic tree guard, initial mulch and a two year guarantee.
