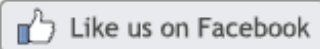
## SMALL BUSINESS FACADE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

## Nominations Sought for 2016 Mayor's Beautification Awards

The Business and Economic Development Commission is currently accepting nominations for the Mayor's 2016 Beautification Awards. These Awards recognize Highland Park businesses that have made improvements to enhance visual appeal consistent with the environment and the community. Award recipients will be granted a Mayoral Certificate and receive public recognition at a 2016 City Council Meeting, in the Highlander, and through a press release issued by the City.

The award is given in five different categories which include Retail, Restaurant, Auto Dealer, Service, Office or Mixed-Use Building. Award criteria includes Façade and Building Appearance; Cleanliness; Window Clarity; Adherence to City Code; Landscaping.
