Wolters Field Advisory Group Meeting Thursday February 3, 2005 Minutes

I. Welcome and Introductions

Meeting was started at 7:00 PM. Brigid Ohlwein, Kevin Fassett, Jeanne Carter, Jim Gaylord, Carolynne Weisenthal, Jeff Annenberg, Mary Anderson, Barry Bolek, and John Grundke were all present. Introductions were made.

II. Landscape meeting Update

Requests were made to trim the landscaping that exists on the district's land. Requests were also made to alter the current ordinance landscaping plan and replace plan with fence to be determined by neighbors and school board at a later date.

III. Community Letter

Community concerns were addressed and discussed for potential solutions. More discussion to be described under V. Neighborhood Issues.

IV. Spring Schedule

The spring schedule of lighted events was distributed. John Grundke reiterated the fact that due to in climate weather, games may have to be changed but the district will stay under the maximum number of event dates for the school year.

V. Neighborhood Issues

One concern of the neighbors was the dust from Athletic Drive. There was discussion about possible solutions and the district will keep the gate to the Athletic Drive closed all year round unless there is a need to use the parking for a major event.

There were also concerns about the fence on the East property line. It needs to be completed in order to be safe for the neighbors and visitors to Wolters Field.

The group discussed the report that needed to be filed with the city in regards to the ordinance. It was decided that the ordinance would be brought to the May meeting in order to put the required report together.

VI. Future Dates

Future dates were discussed and will be solidified for the 2005-06 school year at the May meeting.

VII. Other

The main changes that need to be made for the 2005-06 school year according to the Wolters Field Advisory Group were as follows:

- **Bus parking.** Can bussed remain on site to decrease noise for neighbors and decrease costs for district?
- Locked Gates. Can the gates remain open and unlocked so that neighbors do not have to climb over the fence to get to an event hosted at Wolters Field?
- **Landscaping.** Can the landscaping request as it reads in the ordinance be changed due to the request of the neighbors in the immediate area to the fence mentioned earlier in the meeting?
