

**Wolters Field Advisory Group Meeting**  
**Thursday, February 9, 2006**

- I. The following committee members were present;

- II. It was reported that on Tuesday, February 7, Andy Butler submitted Wolters Field special use permit modifications to the City of Highland Park’s Plan Commission for pre-application. The three modifications requested were related to bus parking, overflow parking on the grass, and fencing along the East property line. Andy reported to the Wolters Advisory group feedback from the plan commission.

- IV. Contest Limitation Resolution – District 113 will submit a resolution to City Council requesting ten additional light dates. The criteria for these additional contests include:
  - The contest would be during the months of October, March, and April.
  - Lights would be used if the contest started in daylight.
  - The lights would be needed to finish the contest safely.
  - The lights would be turned off by 7PM.
  - In addition, the district is requesting any and all post-season games be accommodated within the 35 game limit.
  
- V. The next Wolters Field Advisory meeting will be Thursday, May 11, 2006 in room A-217 at Highland park High School.
  
- VI. Round Table: Brigid Ohlwein asked the School District to consider potential damage by snow plows and snow drifts at the end of each dead end when erecting the new fence. If the special use permit modification is approved. The existing fence has been severely damaged due to the plows and drifting creating an unsafe environment.
