Route 47 Multi-Use Path Construction Planned for 2017

A multi-use (bike/pedestrian) path is planned for construction on Huntley's south side in 2017. This project has been long awaited, and is in direct response from many residents survey comments desiring a safe way for pedestrians and bikers to travel from the south side (predominantly Del Webb's Sun City & Deer Path) and be able to connect with many other multi-use paths throughout the community.

This project consists of the extension of a multi-use path on the east side of Route 47 from the north side of Kreutzer Road to the south side of Oak Creek Parkway. Signalized pedestrian crossings will be added to the west side of Illinois Route 47, including crossings at both the south side of Del Webb Boulevard and the north side of Regency Parkway.

The multi-use path will provide off-road access to Huntley Grove (Walmart), Huntley Crossings Phases I and II, and Village Green (Jewel-Osco), in addition to the internal sidewalks planned through these developments. The project is funded by the Village (20%) and an Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program (ITEP) grant (80%).
