Huntley Police Department to host

DEA National Prescription Drug Take Back Day

Saturday, October 24 from 10:00am - 2:00pm at the Municipal Complex

The Huntley Police Department, in cooperation with the Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) and other law enforcement agencies across the United States, will participate in a program to collect expired and unused prescription medications. The event will be held in front of the Huntley Police Department located at 10911 Main Street in Huntley, from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm on Saturday, October 24. Anyone interested in disposing of such medications, may pull up to the front of the Municipal Complex and dispose of medications, into containers, monitored by a Huntley Police Officer. Liquids and syringes are unable to be accepted. Received medications are then sealed in containers and transported to collections sites for destruction by the DEA.

The Huntley Police Department lobby drug drop off program remains suspended.
