EMERGENCY PERMITTING PROCESS

- Authorized by the Division Commander for typically 6 months - may be extended
- Typically associated with government declaration
- Districts must determine if situation is considered an emergency (see below)
- Corps representatives are located in Marathon and Islamorada to assist
- Consultation with the resource agencies:
 - ▶ May occur after-the-fact
 - ▶ Allows for abbreviated procedures and flexibility
 - ▶ Often addressed through programmatic tools

EXAMPLES OF EMERGENCY REQUESTS WITH PICTURES

- Roadway/transportation repair, replacement
- Shoreline stabilization to address erosion
- Dredging shoaled areas
- Repair, rehabilitation of in-water structures
- Debris removal
- Derelict vessel removal
- Oil/hazardous material cleanup

per 33 CFR 325.2(e)(4), as follows: "An 'emergency' is a situation which would result in an unacceptable hazard to life, a significant loss of property, or an immediate, unforeseen, and significant economic hardship if corrective action requiring a permit is not undertaken within a time period less than the normal time needed to process the permit application under standard procedures."

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
