Proclamation

WHEREAS, on October 16, 1916, ten community leaders met by commission of the Illinois State Auditor to organize Jacksonville Savings and Loan Association; and

WHEREAS, the ten leaders felt strongly that the people of Jacksonville wanted and needed a new way to finance home purchases and ownership; and

WHEREAS, during the last century, countless citizens of all socioeconomic backgrounds have achieved the dream of home ownership with the assistance of Jacksonville Savings Bank; and

WHEREAS, for the past one hundred years, Jacksonville Savings Bank has served as the community leader in the promotion of personal savings and thrift among the citizens of Jacksonville; and
