

Dear Lee County Resident,

Lee County has been designated as a Phase II Stormwater community by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. This in short means that the Lee County Commission is to develop measures to improve and protect the waters of the State that flow through Lee County.

One such measure is education through public participation. Excellent tools for this are Storm Drain Markers (see example below). This is basically a disc that is glued onto a storm drain educating the public that all storm drains lead to larger bodies of water (streams, rivers, lakes, etc.) and should not be used for dumping of other materials.
