The Police Department is investigating a theft that occurred in the 200 block of West San Saba Street. We have had several reports of possible drug activity which are also under investigation. We are also running a joint investigation with the Lampasas County fire investigator on a house fire that occurred earlier this month.

Our Code Enforcement Officer has been directed to issue citations to anybody in violation of the city ordinances. I would encourage everyone to mow their grass and get rid of any unregistered or abandon/junk vehicles. If you received a citation or a letter in the mail and do not take corrective action, the city will contract out to have the work done and you will be responsible for the bill. If the bill is not paid within a certain period of time a lien may be placed against your property. Please keep in mind that if you do receive a citation or letter the police officer is being directed to do this. Any and all complaints should be made to the City Council.
