Notice something “fishy” about the water? Mr. Barker with Corix came to the city council meeting on Feb.6 to address citizens concerns regarding the taste and odor of the water. He explained that due to our cool nights and warm days, the lake water has more organics in the lower depths. When these organics get stirred up it causes the smell and odor. They have treated with Chlorine Dioxide and are starting a treatment with Copper Sulfate near the intake. They also set the levels to pull the water from the higher levels. Hopefully we will see improvement by this weekend!!! Thank you Mr. Barker for your explanation.
