Food Handlers Course March 4th

A food handlers course accredited by the Texas Department of State Health Services is being offered by Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service, Lampasas County. *Food Safety: It's In Your Hands* is scheduled for Saturday, March 4th starting at 8:00 a.m. at Lampasas County Annex Conference Room, 409 S. Pecan St., Lampasas. This 2-hour course will now be required for all food service employees to help promote the service of safe food. The certificate is good for 2 years and is valid anywhere in the State of Texas. The course is a basic overview of food safety practices that are necessary to ensure that safe food is served at your establishment. Practices discussed include good personal hygiene, cross contamination, and time and temperature abuse. To register for the course, call the Extension office at 512-556-8271.

Registration can also be done in-person the day of the course. The cost is \$20.00 per person and must be paid in full before the course begins.

The police department is still working on several ordinance compliance issues. We have been directed to enforce all ordinances that are in effect. One of the ordinances that is being looked at very carefully is the ordinance covering septic tanks. If you live in the city and you are not connected to the waste management system but you are still hooked to the septic tank, you are in violation of the city ordinance. If you have multiple residences and there are separate buildings, each building must be attached to the waste management system. Each residence must have its own trash pickup and attached to its own water supply. It must have electricity. The company that provides the water for Lometa requires each resident to have its own water meter unless you make arrangements with that company. Junk or unregistered vehicles may not be stored within the city limits. I have assigned one officer who will spend a portion of each shift looking for these violations. This is a task that I have been directed to complete. Getting upset with the officer that is enforcing these ordinances will not change anything. We did not make the ordinances but we have been directed to enforce them and we will.
