2:45 PM Welcome and Introductions: Langelan

Marty Langelan (Chestnut St) welcomed the residents, thanked Lauren and Matt Biel for hosting the Open House, and introduced the Council members, Election Committee Members, and Village office staff. She invited residents to contribute their ideas for the neighborhood on the easel-pad set up in the room, and noted the sign-up sheet for people who might like to do more. The Election Committee greeted all the children who were there and thanked them for helping to distribute the Open House flyer throughout the Village.

Susan Fattig (Melville Pl), Council member, spoke about serving as the newest member of the Council. She has enjoyed getting to know Village residents, learning about the issues facing the Village, and finding productive ways to help resolve questions and address residents' concerns.

Natalie Straus Welle (Oxford St) informed residents about the Chevy Chase Fire Board and invited residents to talk to her about the annual fire station open house.

3:00 PM Ethics Committee: Efron

Marc Efron (Raymond St) described how the Committee works with the Code of Ethics of the Village, specifically dealing with conflicts of interest. He noted that there have been no ethics concerns brought to the Committee in the past two years, and said residents are welcome to join the committee.

3:05 PM Community Involvement: Lauren Biel

Lauren Shweder Biel (Delfield St) thanked everyone for coming, invited them to put their ideas on the easel pad, and talked about how we all can build an even more vibrant, rewarding neighborhood here. Lauren and Marty encouraged residents to ask questions, share their community ideas, contact Council and Committee members, and talk to their neighbors -- all it takes is a little imagination to think about what we can do, and a little investment of time.
