Dear Neighbors, Candidates, and Council Members,

Here are the preliminary, unofficial results for the 2024 Village Council Election. There were three open Council seats. The incumbents were the only candidates. All three were re-elected. Their new two-year terms on the Council will run from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2026.

Jeffrey Blander	153 votes
Arthur Alexander	138 votes
Susan Fattig	134 votes

There were also nearly 70 write-in votes this year, naming more than 20 different people.

We will provide more details in the official election report a few days from now, after the Election Committee confirms the final vote counts and certifies the election.

Congratulations to the candidates, and thank you to all the residents of Martin's Additions who voted.

Special thanks to the Village Manager, Michael Silliman, for the excellent staff assistance with the Committee's mailings, notices, meetings, and logistics, and to the Council Vice-Chair, Katie Howard, who provided very helpful support as the Election Committee's Council Liaison this year.
