**DESCRIPTION:** The Metro East Sanitary District assumed Ownership and Maintenance of the Eagle Park Sanitary Sewer Collection System after construction of the project by the United States Army Corp of Engineers for mainline, manholes and tee connections only constructed by the USACE, per the Plans and Specifications for the above-described system prepared by Juneau Associates Inc. P.C. (Identified as job No. E095900, Refer to Exhibit A). The As-Built Sanitary Sewer Data is reference on the attached Exhibit B dated May 27, 2011.

### AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT TO ESTABLISH SANITARY SEWER SERVICE TO EAGLE PARK

This Agreement is made and entered into by and among the City of Madison, Illinois (hereinafter "Madison"), the Metro East Sanitary District (hereinafter "MESD"), the County of Madison, Illinois (through its agency the Madison County Special Service Area, hereinafter "MCSSA"), Venice Township, Illinois (hereinafter "Venice"), and Nameoki Township, Illinois (hereinafter "Nameoki"). The parties are hereinafter referred to as the "Participants".

### ARTICLE I

### GENERAL PROVISIONS

- Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Section 10 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220/1) the Participants continue to use the already developed regional wastewater facility consisting of the Granite City Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant, by virtue of Intergovernmental Agreements.
- Section 2. Madison County has received State and Federal funding for the construction of a sanitary sewer collection system to serve the area commonly known as Eagle Park from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the United States Army Corp of Engineers (hereinafter "USACE").
- Section 3. The Metro East Sanitary District will assume ownership and maintenance of the Eagle Park Sanitary Sewer Collection System after construction of the project by the USACE for main line, manholes, and tee connections only constructed by the USACE (as shown on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein).
- Section 4. The Eagle Park Sanitary Sewer Collection System will discharge flow to the City of Madison for transportation of waste water thru the City of Madison Sewer system at the existing City of Madison manhole 4-5 located on Roosevelt Drive for delivery to the Granite City Regional Waste Water Treatment Plant.
- Section 5. The City of Madison as the owner of a wastewater collection system, which transports waste water to be treated at the Granite City Regional Waste Water Treatment Plant through the MESD Interceptor Sewer System, will accept sewage from the unincorporated area of Madison County for the area commonly known as Eagle Park, for conveyance to the MESD Interceptor sewer in accordance with the water quality standards of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) and/or any other applicable state or federal agency having jurisdiction in such matters.

### **ARTICLE II**

### TERMS OF SERVICE

- Section 1. The City of Madison will accept flow from the Eagle Park Sanitary Sewer Collection System at existing manhole 4-5 located on Roosevelt Drive.
- Section 2. The project will include the construction of improvements to the City of Madison Lift Station LS 4-1 (Viaduct Lift Station) paid for as a part of the project cost to increase the capacity of the lift station to provide for the increased waste water flow from the Eagle

Park Collection Sewer System. Pumps and any equipment removed from the original pumping station shall be the property of the City of Madison.

- Section 3. The MESD will take over ownership and maintenance of the two (2) new lift stations, and one (1) existing lift station 4-1 owned by the City of Madison, and pay 100% of the utility costs to operate the lift stations. All as shown on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- Section 4. The MESD will pay for any improvements and cost for replacement of facilities at the lift station including pumps, electrical control panels and parts associated with the three (3) lift stations described in Article II Section 3.
- Section 5. MCSSA will provide mutual aid support services to furnish equipment and labor when available and not being used for operational needs of the MCSSA Sewer System to include furnishing emergency generators, sewer cleaning and television equipment to maintain sewer service within the Eagle Park Sewer Collection Sewer System.
- Section 6 Madison County agrees, as the project sponsor, to pay the City of Madison \$8,000.00 as payment for the existing lift station to be owned and operated by MESD within sixty (60) days of the ownership transfer.
- Section 7 Venice Township, Nameoki Township and the City of Madison grant, by this agreement, the use of public property, dedicated roadways and alleys for the construction and maintenance of sanitary sewers as shown on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein.

### **ARTICLE III**

### **ARBITRATION**

- Section 1. In the event of a dispute other than default concerning the provisions of this Agreement, the remedy, if any, to the aggrieved party shall be determined by arbitration.
  - A. Upon occurrence of a dispute other than default, any party may petition the other in writing, for arbitration. The Respondent shall answer the Petitioner within thirty (30) days of receipt of the notification of dispute. After thirty (30) days, or upon answer by the Respondent, whichever occurs first, the Petitioner shall arrange for the dispute to be heard by a three member arbitration panel (hereunder "Panel").
  - B. All expenses and salaries of the Arbitrator selected by each government jurisdiction shall be at the expense of that jurisdiction. Any other expenses shall be borne equally by the Parties or shall be incorporated into any Panel award.

### **ARTICLE IV**

### **DEFAULT**

Section 1. In the event of a breach of or failure to perform any duties and obligations set forth herein by one or more of the Participants, a majority vote of remaining Participants can request a default hearing. The party claiming default (the Claimant) shall notify the other party (Respondent) in writing of the nature of the alleged default. The Respondent shall have thirty (30) days in which to answer the allegation. Subsequent to the response, there will be a ninety (90) day period during which the parties shall meet and negotiate to attempt to resolve any claimed default. Should such negotiations fail to resolve the claimed

default, the Claimant shall retain the right to seek all legal and equitable remedies provided by law.

### **ARTICLE V**

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

- Section 1. This Agreement shall be in force for a term of forty (40) years and thereafter shall continue for successive periods of ten (10) years unless terminated or modified by agreement of the Participants. No termination shall be effective without consent of MESD until five (5) years after written notice from City of Madison to MESD of such intended termination. This Agreement shall cease to have any effect if any municipality annexes the area known as Eagle Park including its Sanitary Sewer Collection System.
- Section 2. The Participants have the right to access and copy any and all books, documents and records relating to the purpose and intent of this Agreement and the performance of all Participants. All Participants shall comply with all Federal and State laws regarding public access to documents.
- Section 3. This Agreement may be amended at any time upon the unanimous written consent of the Participants.
- Section 4. This Agreement is subject to such rules, regulations, or laws that may be applicable to similar agreements in this State, and MESD and City of Madison will collaborate in obtaining such permits, certificates, or the like, as may be required to comply therewith.
- Section 5. If any section, subsection, sentence or clause of this Agreement shall be adjudged unconstitutional, or otherwise unlawful, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Agreement as a whole or of any part not adjudged unconstitutional or otherwise unlawful.
- Section 6. This Agreement represents the entire understanding of the parties. No representations, warranties, promises, covenants or undertakings, other than those expressly set forth herein, have been made by either party to the other.

### Section 7. Date:

- A. This Agreement shall be signed, executed and attested by duly authorized officials of appropriate authority and position for each party to this Agreement. At the time of the signing, execution and attestation of the Agreement, each party shall attach to the Agreement a duly certified copy of the appropriate Ordinance which binds that party to this Agreement. It is the intention of each party to have a duplicate original of this Agreement; thus each party will sign two duplicate original Agreements and provide two copies of the Ordinances of acceptance.
- B. This Agreement shall become effective on the date of execution by all parties to this Agreement.
