ORDINANCE OF ADOPTION OF THE
MADISON COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL ALL
HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, Metro East Sanitary District is subject to natural and man-made hazards including floods, tornadoes, severe winter storms, severe thunderstorms, and drought among others, that pose risks to public health and property; and

WHEREAS, the Metro East Sanitary District desires to prepare and mitigate for such natural and man-made hazards; and

WHEREAS, under the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires that local jurisdictions have in place a FEMA-approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a condition for receipt of certain future Federal mitigation funding after November 1, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Multi-Jurisdictional All Hazards Mitigation Plan was updated in accordance with the regulations of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and the guidance provided by FEMA; and

WHEREAS, Metro East Sanitary District has participated in updating the Madison County Multi-Jurisdictional All Hazards Mitigation Plan covering member jurisdictions of Madison.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Metro East Sanitary District hereby:

1. Adopts the Madison County Multi-Jurisdictional All Hazards Mitigation Plan as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of Metro East Sanitary District; and
2. Agrees to participate in the annual and 5-year updates to this Plan.
