

**ORDINANCE NO. 2024-0-005**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AN AGREEMENT WITH  
THE CITY OF GRANITE CITY, CONCERNING TRAINING  
OF DRIVERS SEEKING COMMERCIAL DRIVERS LICENSES**

**WHEREAS**, the Metro East Sanitary District is a Sanitary District created and organized by Illinois Statute 70ILCS 2905// et. Seq; and

**WHEREAS**, the Metro East Sanitary District has approved a collective bargaining agreement with the Teamsters Local Union No. 525, Teamsters Local 50, and Operating Engineers Local 148; and

**WHEREAS**, Articles of those collective bargaining agreements acknowledge every employee's ability to operate a commercial motor vehicle is an integral and essential part of his or her duties at the Metro East Sanitary District and requires each employee to maintain a CDL license; and

**WHEREAS**, the Metro East Sanitary District finds that the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration regulates the training of persons seeking commercial driving licenses, in 40 CFR 380.700 through 380.725; and

**WHEREAS**, the Metro East Sanitary District hereby finds instructors who train drivers seeking commercial drivers licenses, should address 49 CFR 380.713 and 49 CFR 380.605, among other regulations enforced by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration; and

**WHEREAS**, the Metro East Sanitary District is advised that, in order to provide entry-level driver training for commercial drivers licensees, training providers must be listed on the Training Provider Registry of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, per 49 CFR 380.700, et. Seq; and

**WHEREAS**, the Metro East Sanitary District is advised it may promote efficiency in the Metro East Sanitary District work, should the Metro East Sanitary District employ qualified, entry-level driver training providers registered with the Federal Carrier Safety Administration;

and

**WHEREAS**, the Metro East Sanitary District is advised the City of Granite City is similarly interested in exploring the possibility of participating in the entry-level commercial driver training of Granite City employees, in conjunction with the Metro East Sanitary District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Metro East Sanitary District hereby finds it may promote efficiency to negotiate an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Granite City, in which the costs of qualifying, training, registering, and employing an entry-level drivers' trainer, would be shared by Metro East Sanitary District and the City of Granite City.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Commissioners of the Metro East Sanitary District, in Madison and St. Clair Counties and the State of Illinois, that the President of the Board is authorized to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the City of Granite City concerning sharing the costs and employee resources to train, qualify, register, and/or employ, a provider of entry-level driver training for operation of the commercial vehicles of the Metro East Sanitary District and the City of Granite City Public works Department.

The Board President is to report back to the Metro East Sanitary District Board of Commissioners within 60 days concerning this Resolution.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage, and may be published by the Office of the City Clerk.
