

# RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 669

Passed October 3, 1978

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING VILLAGE INCOME TAX TO ONE PERCENT (.01) PER ANNUM AND ELIMINATING CREDIT FOR TAX PAID TO ANOTHER MUNICIPALITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Ordinance No. 444 and Ordinance No. 445; and to declare an emergency,

Now, Therefore Be It Ordained By The Council Of The Village Of Milford, Clermont And Hamilton Counties, Ohio.

Section 1. Increase In Tax.

The Milford Village Earnings Tax as set forth and delineated in Ordinance No. 444 and Ordinance No. 445 is hereby increased from the rate of five-tenths of one percent (.005) per annum to one percent (.01) per annum.

Section 2. Amendment.

Article III A 1.a, 2a., 3a.1, 3b.2, 4a.1, 4b.2 and 5a. of Ordinance No. 445 and Sections III A and VI A of Ordinance No. 444 are hereby amended as follows: "one percent (.01)" shall be substituted for "five-tenths of one percent (.005)".

Section 3. Elimination of Credit.

There shall be no credit allowed for tax paid in another municipality as provided for in Article XV of Ordinance No. 445 and Section XV of Ordinance No. 444 and said Article XV and Section XV are hereby abolished and repealed.

Section 4. Priority.

This Ordinance shall amend Ordinance No. 444 and Ordinance No. 445 to the extent set forth herein and shall supersede any provisions of any Ordinance or Resolution which are inconsistent herewith.

Section 5. Emergency.

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in that its enactment into law is necessary for the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Milford; and that it is necessary to obtain the additional revenue required for the operation of the Village of Milford government during the year 1978 and thereafter.
