

## Administrative Services Committee Meeting Minutes September 28, 2023

Mr. Parrish called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Proceedings: Approve the proceedings from the July 17, 2023, Administrative Services

Committee Minutes. Ms. Chamberland made a motion to approve.

Seconded by Mr. Parrish. Ms. Evans abstain.

# DISCUSSION: REBATE OF PROPERTY TAX TO JLC REAL ESTATE LLC DBA MILFORD FAMILY DENTISTRY

Mr. Doss reviewed and discussed with the committee property tax rebate information for JLC Real Estate LLC dba\_Milford Family Dentistry. There was a discussion regarding the reimbursement amount of the rebate. The five years for the Property Tax Rebate Incentive Program would start when they acquired their current property (former PNC Bank location). The committee agreed to reimburse JLC Real Estate LLC dba Milford Family Dentistry a five-year period reimbursement starting with tax years 2020 to 2022 (payable 2021 to 2023) in a lump sum of \$8,678.59. The subsequent tax years for the rebate will be made payable for each remaining tax year under the program.

THE COMMITTEE AGREED TO RECOMMEND THAT THE LAW DIRECTOR PREPARE AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE REBATE OF PROPERTY TAX TO MILFORD FAMILY DENTISTRY FOR FIVE YEARS WITH THE FIRST REBATE LUM SUM AMOUNT OF \$8,678.59 FOR TAX YEARS 2020 TO 2022 (PAYABLE 2021 TO 2023)

## <u>DISCUSSION: REPEAL OF MILFORD PROPERTY TAX REBATE INCENTIVE</u> PROGRAM

Mr. Doss Discussed Repealing Ordinance 17-1260 -Milford Property Tax Rebate Incentive Program. There was further discussion to possibly bring this program back in the future. Mr. Doss said that there are currently some available programs through the Community Reinvestment Act (CRA).


# <u>DISCUSSION: FIVE POINTS LANDING CHANGE ORDER – PARKING LOT ENTRANCE</u>

Mr. Doss wanted to bring before the committee information regarding a change order in the amount of \$6,802.95 which is all part of the collective expense that has been put into the Five Points Landing Park. The Change Order was required when they started to dig out and mill down to put in the base, there were divots that were starting to sink since it was not steady within the soil. They had to place some sub grade to stabilize the entrance and exit surface of the parking lot.

THE COMMITTEE AGREED TO RECOMMEND THAT THE LAW DIRECTOR DRAFT AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE CHANGE ORDER ASSOCIATED WITH UNDERCUT MAIN PARKING LOT ENTRY AT THE FIVE POINTS LANDING PARK PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,802.95

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



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

As you know, I am currently handling this claim at Zurich involving the claimant, Tara Menkhaus. As a reminder, the claimant is suing the City of Milford regarding a new ordinance covering short term rentals. The claimant is seeking a retraining order and an injunction against the City. This claim is covered under the City's Public Officials E&O Liability policy, policy period 5/13/22-5/13/23. There is an Amendatory Endorsement to the policy for non-monetary damages, which states that Zurich will provide defense costs up to \$25,000. This matter falls under this Endorsement.

It has come to our attention that Zurich paid more than the monetary defense limit of \$25,000 to the defense firm currently handling this matter (Dinsmore Shohl). I have brought this to the attention of the handling attorney, Bryan Pacheco, Esq., to rectify the situation. Going forward, the defense firm will bill the City directly for future legal services for this matter.





## CHANGE TO SCOPE OF SERVICES AND FEES

This **SUPPLEMENT to AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES** to the original Agreement for Services (original Agreement dated 03/22/2023) is between City of Milford OH ("Client") and Terracon Consultants, Inc. ("Consultant") for additional or changed Services to be provided by Consultant for Client on the Project, as described in the Agreement for Services. This Supplement is incorporated into and part of the Agreement for Services.

 Scope of Services. The scope of the additional or changed Services are described in the Scope of Services section of the Consultant's Supplemental Proposal, unless Services are otherwise described below or in Exhibit B to this Supplement (which section or exhibit are incorporated into the Supplement).


Based on the BUSTR letter (for Terracon project N1237127) and our conversation with Bryan Duzak the BUSTR site coordinator for your site, the soil is not delineated to the BUSTR TGM 2012 applicable action levels. Terracon recommends the following scope of work:

- Advance two (2) soil borings to 20 feet below ground surface (bgs) as shown on the attached exhibit. Install two (2) monitoring wells completed in the boring locations south and west of MW-11 off-site.
- Submit four soil samples two from each boring for analysis of benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and xylenes (BTEX), methyl tertiary butyl ether (MTBE), and total petroleum hydrocarbons gasoline range (TPH-GRO), in accordance with US Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA) Methods 8260 and 8015, respectively for soil samples.
- Develop the newly installed monitoring wells.
- Gauge and collect one round of groundwater samples from 17 monitoring wells. Purge water will be containerized for disposal. The samples will be submitted for laboratory analysis of BUSTR Analytical Group 1 which will include benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and xylenes (BTEX), methyl tertiary butyl ether (MTBE), in accordance with US Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA) Methods 8260, for the groundwater samples.
- Evaluate groundwater ingestion pathways using default action levels and revise the tables to reflect the BUSTR 2012 action levels.
- If analytical results indicate soil and groundwater are delineated to Tier 1 default action levels, Terracon will revise the BUSTRscreen fate & and transport modeling of the groundwater impacts and develop preliminary site-specific target levels (SSTLs) using **default input parameters**. If additional delineation is required and or site-specific target levels require development, Terracon will provide a cost proposal for these additional services.
- Terracon is under the assumption that the boring/monitoring well locations will be accessible and cleared for utilities, permitting for sidewalk/roadway openings, and any required traffic controls will be provided by the city. Repairs to damaged surfaces is not included.
- 2. Compensation. Client shall pay compensation for the additional or changed Services performed at the fees stated in the Supplemental Proposal unless fees are otherwise stated below or in Exhibit C to this Supplement (which section or exhibit are incorporated into the Supplement).

The scope of services outlined above will be performed for a lump sum cost of \$14,750.00
