Chief Baird thanked the families that invited Santa and the MCFD to stop over during Santa Sunday event December 18th. Congratulate several of his employees on Various training classes.


Council Comments Ms. Chamberland wanted to thank all of the residents and businesses in the city for doing such a wonderful job decorating for the holidays.
