The Council of the City of Milford met in Special Session in Council Chambers at 745 Center Street at 6:00 p.m. on July 19, 2017. Mayor Howland called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance and a Moment of Silence.

Roll Call: Present: Mayor Howland, Vice Mayor Brewer, Ms. Russell, Mr. Haskins, Ms. Evans Mr. Brady is on vacation. Ms. Evans made a motion to excuse Mr. Brady who was on vacation and to excuse Mr. Albrecht was running late. Seconded by Ms. Brewer. All voted yes

Standing Committee Reports:

City of Milford Public Services Committee Minutes 7/17/2017

Called to Order: 8:00 a.m. by Amy Brewer Present: Amy Brewer, Fred Albrecht

Staff: Michael Doss, City Manager; Nate Clayton, Public Works Director; Matt Newman, Asst. Public Works Director; Lori Pegg, Community Services Manager; The committee agreed to approve the absence of Ed Brady. *OPWC Emergency Funding Application-SR 126 Culvert Repair*

Mr. Clayton advised that the City had been awarded \$136,000 in emergency funds from the OPWC for the repair on SR 126/Glendale Milford Rd pending approval and an ordinance from City Council. The committee agreed to draft an ordinance authorizing the City of Milford to prepare and submit an application to the Ohio Public Works Commission State Capital Improvement program for emergency funding for the SR126/Glendale Milford culvert repair. Ms. Howland seconded the motion. All voted yes 2018 OPWC Project Submission

Mr. Clayton provided information on three projects that the Public Works Department intends to seek Ohio Public Works Commission funds for in 2018. These three projects were recommended in the Capital Improvement Plan earlier this year.

Laurel Avenue Storm Sewer Improvements: This project will help with the flooding in south Milford when heavy rain falls. The project will include the addition of storm sewers from Mill down Laurel and outfall at the end of Gatch or Laurel and tie in dry wells. An application will be made to the Ohio Public Works Commission with a commitment of 51% funding from the storm sewer capital fund.

The committee agreed to draft an ordinance authorizing application to the Ohio Public Works Commission for the Laurel Avenue Storm Sewer Improvements Project. Ms. Howland seconded the motion. All voted yes

SR 126/Glendale Milford Rd Rehabilitation and Culvert Remediation: The project includes mill and overlay of the asphalt surface with base repairs replacement of the existing curb with curb and gutter, guardrail upgrades and repair of Glendale Milford Road culvert and outlet past Shawnee Run Rd. ODOT will be paving the road in 2019. An application will be made to the Ohio Public Works Commission with a commitment of 51% funding from the storm sewer capital fund.

The committee agreed to draft an ordinance authorizing application to the Ohio Public Works Commission for the SR126/Glendale Milford Rd rehabilitation and culvert remediation. Ms. Russell seconded the motion. All voted yes

Price Road Stream Bank Remediation Project: The road is starting to slip due to storm water erosion. The project includes roadway stabilization using reinforced concrete piles to remediate slope erosion approaching the edge of the pavement. An application will be made to the Ohio Public Works Commission with a commitment of 51% funding from the storm sewer capital fund. The committee agreed to draft an ordinance authorizing application to the Ohio Public Works Commission for the Price Road Stream Bank Remediation Project. Ms. Evans seconded the motion. All voted yes

Ms. Brewer wanted to mention that the one of the things Mr. Albrecht and Ms. Brewer had discussed in the Public Works Committee meeting was that a lot of the projects we are working on now are projects that are in need of repair currently, but some of them are proactive situations. We can see that a problem is imminent and so being a little proactive so that we do not get into a situation where we need emergency funding or do not have time to bid it out. I would like to applaud our Public Works Director-Nate Clayton and the City Manager-Michael Doss for thinking forward and work on these projects with the appropriate funding. There being no other business the committee adjourned at 8:30am.

Ms. Howland wanted to inform that Ed Brady will be coming off Public Services Committee and becoming a member of the Safety Services Committee. And Ms. Howland will now be a member of the Public Services Committee and off the Safety Service Committee.

Ms. Evans had a request from a resident: Route 131 at the merge near the Route 50 intersection. There are cars that slip off the edge of the road and they get stuck. They wanted to know if we could put up a guardrail of fill dirt to help this from happening. Mr. Doss stated that he would have Public Works look into this.
