

Safety Services Committee Meeting Minutes April 15, 2021

Mr. Mitchell called the meeting to order at 5:35 p.m.

Present: Kyle Mitchell, Lisa Evans and Ben Redman

Staff: City Manager, Michael Doss

Visitors: Several residents

<u>Proceedings</u>: Approve the proceedings from the April 5, 2021 Safety Services Committee Minutes. Mr. Redman made a motion to approve. Seconded by Mr. Mitchel. Mrs. Evans abstained

Truck Weight Limits and Proposed Ordinance 2021-80

Mr. Doss stated that City Law Director Mike Minniear drafted language for a proposed ordinance related to amending Section 351.07 regarding parking and storage of vehicles. Mr. Doss said that the language in the proposed ordinance only pertains to parking and storage and does not pertain to the use of local streets which is set forth in 339.02. The language increases the gross vehicle weight for semitrailers and trucks from 10,000 pounds to 14,000 pounds.

Mrs. Evans stated that this is the same weight increase that has been discussed in prior Safety Services Committee meetings. Mr. Mitchell affirmed.

Mr. Doss mentioned that this draft language does not include any items addressing recreational vehicles (RVs) and that Mr. Minniear and Ms. Holbrook were working on draft language for that subject.

Without further Committee discussion....

The Committee agree to recommend that the Law Director draft an ordinance amending Section 351.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Milford regarding parking and storage of vehicles increasing the GVWR for semitrailers and trucks to 14,000 pounds.

Pedestrian Crossing and Red -light Stoppage at SR 126/US50 Discussion

Mr. Redman presented a topic mentioned by a citizen at a previous City Council meeting regarding pedestrian/bicycle safety concerns involving vehicles at the intersection of SR 126/US 50.

Mr. Doss stated that several improvements were recently made at the intersection including a four-way stop crosswalk signal relay for pedestrians and bicyclists as well as signage indicating yield to pedestrians. Mr. Doss indicated that since both roads are State routes, vehicles must stop at a red light before turning right on red at all intersection areas. Mr. Doss stated that he spoke to Chief Jamey Mills about the situation and Chief Mills affirmed that ODOT concluded that motorist can perform a right on red at that intersection. Mr. Doss believes that the issue is likely related to motorist not adhering to the traffic laws and yielding to pedestrians at the intersection red lights.

Darryl Donovan stated that the turn signal coming from the Indian Hill area across the bridge doesn't hold very long and stops up traffic during peak times.

Rebecca Shundich spoke about cars not even stopping at the red light crossing the bridge into Milford.

Mr. Doss believes that the issue is likely related to motorist not adhering to the traffic laws and yielding to pedestrians at the intersection red lights.

The committee recommended that Mr. Doss have a conversation with Chief Mills about providing some type of police presence to monitor any vehicles not stopping before turning during a red light.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 5:54 p.m. with a motion from Mr. Redman, Seconded by Mrs. Evans. All agreed.

6.07 Original Appointment Exams: Police

- A. In relation to examinations for positions within the Division of Police of the city, examinations for original appointments may include written testing, oral testing, and/or an assessment center.
- B. Content of examinations. The entrance examination process held to establish a list of eligible candidates for any classification shall consist of one or more of the following parts listed below. The Civil Service Commission may at its discretion include other examination methods not listed below as part of an entrance examination process provided at least one of the following parts are included in the examination process:
 - 1. Written test. This part, when required, shall include a written demonstration design to show the knowledge necessary to perform the responsibility of the class of positions to which the examinee seeks appointment. Additionally, such test shall assess the examinee's use and knowledge of the English language, the range of his or her general information, or his or her general educational attainments.
 - 2. Oral test. This part, when required, shall include a personal interview with the Civil Service Commission or its designee for a class of positions where ability to deal with other persons, to meet the public, or other personal qualifications are to be determined. An oral test may also be used in examinations where a written test is unnecessary or impracticable.

3. Performance tests. This part, when required, shall include such test of performance to determine the ability and skill of competitors to perform the work involved in the position to which the applicant seeks appointment.



Written tests may be prepared, conducted and graded by disinterested persons retained by the Personnel Commission.

Examinations shall be practical in character and shall relate directly to those matters which will fairly test the relative capability of the person being examined to discharge the particular duties of the position for which appointment is sought.

The Commission shall prescribe the subjects of each examination and the relative weights to be assigned thereto; provided that any such determination must have been made prior to the date of such examination.

6.07 Original Appointment Exams: Police

- A. In relation to examinations for positions within the Division of Police of the City, examinations for original appointments may include written testing, oral testing, and/or an assessment center.
- B. No applicant shall be tested orally or participate in the assessment center unless he or she has completed the applicable written test, and, without consideration of any credits provided for by these rules, achieved the minimum passing score which has been predetermined by the Commission.

C. If oral examinations of qualified applicants are given, they shall be prepared, Conducted and graded by an Interviewing Board designated by the Personnel Commission. A minimum passing grade which has been predetermined by the Commission on the oral portion of the examination, without consideration of any credits provided for by these rules, shall be required as a prerequisite for further consideration for employment or appointment, and for certification to an eligible list.

6.08 Medical, Physical, Psychological, or Drug Testing

A. General

Whenever physical and/or psychological qualifications are of special importance, the applicant shall be required to pass a physical and/or psychological examination and be certified as qualified in such respect, whether before admission to the examination, or before being placed on the appropriate eligible list, or before certification for appointment, as the Commission may deem advisable.

B. Controlled Substances

Such examinations may include a screening for the use of controlled substances.
