New ADAMHS Board Leadership Announced

The Montgomery County Alcohol, Drug Addiction & Mental Health Board (ADAMHS) is pleased to announce its new board officers for 2015.

Anthony Whitmore who has served on the ADAMHS Board since 2007, is now chair of the 12 member board. The Dayton resident is director of Government and Community Relations for the Greater Dayton Regional Transit Authority. Whitmore replaces Stan Eichenauer of Dayton, who remains on the board after serving as chair for three and a half years.

"The work of ADAMHS is extremely important to this community and I am humbled to have the opportunity to serve the citizens of Montgomery County in such a way that provides real results," said Whitmore.

Whitmore is President of the 2015 Martin Luther King Dayton celebration and has offered his expertise to numerous local, state and national organizations including the Kiwanis Club Board and the Campfire USA Board.

Board members are typically appointed by county commissioners to four year terms, however six board seats are filled by the Ohio Department of Mental Health & Addiction Services.
