## SECTION 7. FEES AND CHARGES

6. Oceanfront Employee Parking Decal Program:
  - Fee: \$50.00 per year (expires December 31 of every year, regardless of purchase date).
  - Eligibility: Must provide proof of current employment at a business addresses located on the east side of Kings Highway.
  - Use limitations: Decal is valid in any public parking space with a POM Meter (base model parking meter accepting coins only). Decal is not valid at any City beach access or parking space utilizing a pay-by-phone-ONLY zone, pay-station, or Mackay Meter (i.e. "smart meter" accepting physical credit card payment).

Passed and adopted by the City Council for the City this 10<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2020.

## \*\*\* PARKING INSTRUCTIONS | PLEASE READ \*\*\*

*Eligibility Requirements: Must be directly employed by a business located East of Kings Highway to oceanfront.*

## VALID at any POM Meter in the City

What is a POM Meter?

A - Base model accepts coins only

Where are the POM Meters?

A - Typically 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> row parking

How many spots available?

A - 1,465 Citywide



## NOT VALID Anywhere Else...

**NO:** Beach Accesses | "Smart" Meters | or Pay-by-Phone-ONLY areas

Will I know if I'm parked at one of these locations?

A - Yes, parking payment methods are clearly marked with signage if a physical meter is not present.

Why can't I park here?

A - Pay Stations and Smart Meter locations are found throughout the City in close proximity to the ocean, therefore are naturally high revenue generating locations and reserved to be utilized by visitors and other preferred city decals systems, such as \$30 weekly passes.
