

CHIEF'S SUMMARY 2008

The Pekin Police Department command staff changed this year with the retirement of Deputy Chief Jim Brecher and Lieutenant Gary Lowe. Two new Sergeants, two new Lieutenants and a Deputy Chief have been promoted. Additionally, four new Patrolmen were hired in the last year, bringing the department up to full strength of fifty-six sworn police officers.

The department tried an experimental 10-hour shift program allowing manpower to be staggered at shift changes for availability at peak times of calls for service. The plan was discontinued at the end of one year for economic reasons.

Two City Ordinances were passed pertaining to traffic enforcement. The first ordinance imposes an administrative fee charged to owners whose vehicles are towed for certain traffic violations and criminal charges. The second ordinance allows defendants who commit ordinance violations to pay their fines at the police station rather than being processed through the court system.


One of the department's citizen volunteers logged over 1000 hours of service overseeing the false alarm ordinance. His hard work helped reduce business false alarms from a high of 3 to 4 alarms per day to approximately one alarm per day. Additionally, he updated the call-out lists for all the businesses in Pekin.

Two Pekin Police Department Sergeants graduated from the Northwestern University School of Staff and Command.



Crime Prevention

The Pekin Police Department appreciates the expendiency of reconciling unlawful conduct by way of an informed and knowledgeable public. Hence, the Pekin Police Department appoints a sworn police officer to execute the undertakings of Public Information Officer and Investigator to support and maintain an alert community. Understanding that citizens are more than customers, and share a responsibility in halting misdeeds, the Pekin Police Department employs numerous forms of media to report to the population. Some of these forms are daily newspapers, public service announcements, and government access television. Additionally, the officer in this position will coordinate programs such as Crime Stoppers, Night Our Against Crime, Cops for Kids, and Shop with a Hero. For these reasons, the Pekin Police Department considers the Public Information Officer/Investigator responsibilities significant to the faithfulness of its mission statement.

National Night Out Against Crime

The 2008 National Night Out Against Crime was attended by approximately 800 people. There were approximately 30 local service agencies participating at the Dragons Dome. The activities for the evening included:

Da.R.E. 2008

D.A.R.E. 2008

D.A.R.E (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) is a 10 week program designed to teach kids about the harmful effects of drugs and violence. Students are taught to consider the physical, legal, social, and emotional consequences for using drugs. They are also taught how to make good decisions by learning to deal with peer pressure, self pressure, stress, and self esteem issues in a positive drug free way.

In Pekin, D.A.R.E. is taught at four schools:

In 2008, over 467 students graduated from the D.A.R.E. program. In addition, 51 preschoolers were given instruction on Stranger Danger.



Training 2008



Pekin Police Department logged approximately 4500 hours of training, both internally and externally, in more than ten substantive areas during 2008. Some of the highlights include:

- · Two officers completed and were certified as Juvenile Officers
- Two officers attended Northwestern University's School of Police Staff and Command
- · Three officers attended and were certified as Field Training Officers
- Two officers attended Basic Hostage Negotiations
- · Four officers attended a management rights seminar
- Four officers continued through Accident Investigation certification by attending Accident Investigation II
 and while two officers attended Traffic Accident Reconstruction I
- Eleven officers attended a variety of DUI enforcement courses
- Five officers attended training on motorcycle gang investigations
- Four officers attended training allowing them to become bicycle officers
- Officers assigned to the Investigations Unit attended a wide variety of training in interviewing and evidence collection
- Three officers attended training involving identity theft and assisting its victims

The Pekin Police Department has continued to work diligently at meeting its training goals for 2008. The Department was able to send two officers through the School of Staff and Command; certify two more officers as juvenile officers; certified and trained three more field training officers; and continued sending officers through the accident reconstruction series.


