



KNOW YOUR SNOW RESPONSIBILITY

In accordance with city ordinance and the Americans with Disabilities Act, residents and businesses are required to remove snow and ice from public sidewalks adjacent to or abutting their property. **Sidewalks must be cleared to a minimum of four feet wide.** Please help keep residents safe by clearing your sidewalks!



RESIDENTIAL



- If **more than 2"** of snow has accumulated, clear sidewalks **within 48 hours** after roadway is plowed. Always remove any ice, sleet, or freezing rain.
- Sidewalks listed on the Performed Sidewalk Snow Removal List will be cleared by City of Pekin.

COMMERCIAL



- If **less than 6"** of snow has accumulated, clear sidewalks **within 24 hours** after snow stops falling.
- If **more than 6"** of snow has accumulated, clear sidewalks **within 36 hours** after snow stops falling.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEARING MY SIDEWALK?

Property dwellers, including all single and multifamily residential properties, must remove snow. Sidewalks touching curbs along the following roadways are cleared by the City of Pekin: Parkway, Broadway, 14th, Ann Eliza, Margaret, and Court Street (excluding downtown).

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF MY SIDEWALKS ARE NOT CLEARED BY THE ALLOTTED TIME?

A "Notice of Non-Compliance" will be issued to the residence with an additional 48 hours to comply. A civil penalty could be issued with failure to comply to a second notice.

WHAT IF IT SNOWS AGAIN?

If multiple snow events occur, the compliance time-clock resets to the end of the most recent snowfall. Sign-up for Nixle Alerts to stay informed on parking bans and time-clocks: Text 61554 to 888777.

WHO CAN HELP MY CLEAR MY SIDEWALKS?
