Discussion: Attorney Bosich pointed out some items that needed changed on his liquor application. Mr. Monseur changed those specified and Paula notarized his signature.

Police Chief Dossey made a motion to approve the liquor license for Krystal's, Inc. dba Krystal's at 2111 Court Street, Suite C contingent upon the installation of the video equipment and for Deputy Liquor Commissioner VonRohr to get out there to do his walk-thru, Seconded by Fire Chief Nelson. On roll call vote all present voted Aye. Motion carried.

Attorney Bosich received a phone call regarding Begu99 Inc. dba Bina's Place. Items from their liquor application that was submitted at the January meeting was missing the lease and liquor liability insurance and a few changes on the application. Those were turned in and also application was corrected. They were just

waiting for the background check to come back from the manager. As of Tuesday, the 9<sup>th</sup> at 4:00pm it wasn't back, so they were taken off the Agenda. Pat, spokesperson for Blerim "Ben" Bekir asked the Commission if they would still hold their regular Liquor Commission meeting on Thursday, February 25<sup>th</sup>.

Liquor Commissioner McCabe entered the meeting at 4:21pm.

### **ANY OTHER BUSINESS**

Deputy Liquor Commissioner VonRohr stated we will have our regularly scheduled liquor commission meeting on Thursday, February 25<sup>th</sup> at 4:00pm. There will be a few other things on the agenda.

Attorney Bosich stated the late 2% Food and Beverage taxes that were are late that the letters are ready to go out: of late 2% Food and Beverage tax. Late are Pekin Amvet's – 6 months in arrears; Goodfella's – 4 months in arrears; Doc's Supper Club – 3 months in arrears. Attorney Sue Bosich will write up notices to these businesses.

Ol' Dad's will be on the next Liquor Commission Agenda. They are in violation of the State liquor code for smoking inside the premises.

Deputy Liquor Commissioner VonRohr stated he is unable to make contact with Chad Ball of The High Note. His phone is not on, drove by his address and no one lives there. The upstairs window is still not fixed and that poses as a safety hazard. Fire Chief Nelson and VonRohr will go on Friday to take care of this and also pull the liquor license.

Liquor Commission Member Vonderheide made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Fire Chief Nelson.
