**September 3, 2013 6:00PM**

**MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE:** Connie Hargis, Bob Mack, Carol Huff, Chris Brown, Mayor Harold Goffinet, Clerk-Treasurer Susie Roberts, City Attorney John Hargis.

**PLEDGE:** The *Pledge of Allegiance* was said by all in attendance.

**MINUTES APPROVAL:** Bob made a motion to approve the minutes from our regular meeting held on August 6, 2013; Connie seconded the motion. All were in favor and the minutes were approved. Chris made a motion to approve the minutes from our Special meeting held on August 12, 2013; Bob seconded the motion. All were in favor and the minutes were approved. Carol made a motion to approve the minutes from the Special meeting held on August 19, 2013; Connie seconded the motion. All were in favor and the minutes were approved.

**CHARLIE FINECY MUSEUM UPDATE:** Charlie appeared before the council and reported to them about the past months' activities. The movie "The Kentuckian" was shown in the village in August to a very receptive crowd. He also mentioned that the test shots have been done in the village for the possibility of a movie "shoot". He is still looking at installing security cameras at the museum.

**DJ CAFÉ:** Phil Brown will send the property owner the inspection sheet. Upon receipt of that – the property owner will have sixty days to complete the items mentioned.

**ADA RESOLUTION:** The purpose of this resolution, 2013-4, is to adopt a grievance policy to allow a person to lodge a complaint regarding ADA compliance. It proposes that the mayor be the ADA Coordinator to handle any complaints. All members present approved the resolution; Ferman Yearby – absent.

**GENTRY BUILDING WALL:** Betsy, from Kiva, will be providing the city with a report on what needs to be done. Once we receive this information John Hargis will draw up an agreement for the property owner to sign. Bob made a motion to proceed with the repairs to the west wall once we receive the report from Betsy; Connie seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion was approved.

**ACCEPTANCE OF ANNEXED STREETS/MVH:** City attorney, John Hargis, presented the council with a plat showing the additional roads that the city has acquired, due to annexation. Carol made a motion to accept the additional roads into the city; Connie seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion was approved.

**ORDINANCE 2013-7 (SATURDAY HOURS):** Carol made a motion to suspend the rules to allow passage on the night of introduction; Connie seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion was passed. Bob made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2013-7; Chris seconded the motion. All were in favor and the ordinance was passed.

**BUDGET APPROVAL:** This is our public hearing for our 2014 budget. There were no inquires from the audience. Our adoption meeting will be held on October 1, 2013 at 6:00 pm. Carol made a motion to approve the budget; Bob seconded the motion. All were in favor and the budget was approved.

**OLD BUSINESS:** The city has received a request to purchase the west building of the Auto Parts Building. John Hargis stated that there is a certain procedure that the city needs to follow to sell the property.

**NEW BUSINESS:** We received a quote for \$7,500 from JBI Construction to add curbing and guttering to the north side of Seminary Street between Eighth and Ninth Streets. Chris made a motion to allow JBI to complete the curb and guttering on the north side of Seminary Street; Connie seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion was approved.

**CLAIMS:** Claims were signed.

**ADJOURNMENT:** Carol made a motion to adjourn the meeting; Bob seconded the motion. All were in favor and the meeting was adjourned.
